# PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE (PAC) 2011 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT February 22-25-26, 2011 - Campus Sites

## PAC TOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND GAMES - 2/22/11 First Round Game #1 - Crestview Hills, Ky.

#1 THOMAS MORE 68, #8 Thiel 47

The eighth-seeded Tomcats hung around for a half against the top-seeded and #1-ranked Saints, trailing by just nine (34-25) at intermission. However, Thomas More took control in the final 20 minutes to clinch hosting rights for the weekend "final four." Senior C Nicole Dickman (Park Hills, KY/Notre Dame Academy H.S.) led TMC with 18 points, while sophomore G Chelsea Tolliver (Morning View, KY/Simon Kenton H.S.) added 13 markers. Freshman F Moriah Corey (Louisville, KY/Butler H.S.) came off the bench to grab a team-best eight rebounds. For Thiel, sophomore F Kelly Barzak (Warren, OH/Howland H.S.) bucketed a team-high 18 points in the loss, while sophomore G Kelly Muffley (Salsburg, PA/Western Reserve Academy H.S.) added 15 for the Tomcats.

### First Round Game #2 - Latrobe, Pa. #2 SAINT VINCENT 64, #7 Chatham 47

The #19-ranked Bearcats celebrated their first-ever PAC Tournament contest by racing to a 30-14 halftime advantage over the visiting Cougars, then cruising to the opening round win. The top gun for Saint Vincent was junior F Brittany Sedlock (Northern Cambria, PA/Northern Cambria H.S.), who scored a game-high 25 points. Junior G Emily Fenton (Latrobe, PA/Greater Latrobe H.S.) and sophomore F Devin McGrath (Robinson Twp., PA/Our Lady of Sacred Heart H.S.) each added 10 markers for the victors. Chatham was led by senior C Sonjia Huston (Homestead, PA/Wilkinsburg H.S.) with a team-best 14 points and eight rebounds, while first-year F Carly Zelenak (Mount Pleasant, PA/Mount Pleasant H.S.) added 10 markers off the bench in defeat.

#### First Round Game #3 - Waynesburg, Pa.

#3 WAYNESBURG 52, #6 Washington & Jefferson 42

The Yellow Jackets completed a three-game season sweep of their local rivals, while winning their first PAC Tournament game since 2005-06. The game was a defensive struggle throughout, with WU taking a 28-22 halftime lead and the Presidents getting no closer than three in the second half. Senior F Elisha Jones (Russell, PA/Eisenhower H.S.) was the lone Yellow Jacket to score in double figures, finishing with 13 points. Junior PG Hannah Hunter (Hopewell, PA/Hopewell H.S.) added nine points and a team-best seven assists, while sophomore G Brittany Spencer (Baltimore, MD/New Town H.S.) added eight-markers and a team-high 11 rebounds. For the Presidents, junior G Vanessa Rivera (Reading, PA/Wilson H.S.) and junior F Ashley Kirkpatrick (Sharon, PA/Kennedy Catholic H.S.) each bucketed 11 points in the loss.

#### First Round Game #4 - Bethany, W.Va.

#5 Grove City 66, #4 BETHANY 59

The lone upset of the opening round saw the Wolverines overcome a 28-23 halftime deficit by outscoring the host Bison 43-31 in

the decisive second half. The key to victory was at the foul line, where GCC went 27-of-29 (93.1%), including a perfect 21-of-21 in the final 20 minutes. Four Wolverine scorers reached double digits, led by junior G Megan Gebrosky (Cranberry Twp., PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) with a team-high 18 points to go along with four assists. Senior F Alison Wells (Waterville, VT/Lamoille H.S.) and sophomore G Leah Gibson (North Canton, OH/Hoover H.S.) added 14 and 12 points, respectively. Bethany was led by senior G Tara Harris (Zanesville, OH/Zanesville H.S.) with a game-high 20 points in her final collegiate contest, while junior G Anne Wilson (Saegertown, PA/Cambridge Springs H.S.) added 19 markers for the Bison.

# PAC TOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL GAMES - 2/25/11 Semifinal Game #1 - Crestview Hills, Ky.

#2 SAINT VINCENT 70, #3 Waynesburg 53

The Bearcats advanced to the PAC title game for the first time, as Saint Vincent jumped out to a quick 25-6 advantage over the Yellow Jackets in the game's opening seven minutes and never looked back. All five SVC starters posted double-digit scoring totals, led by junior G Emily Fenton (Latrobe, PA/Greater Latrobe H.S.) with a team-high 18 points. Junior F Brittany Sedlock (Northern Cambria, PA/Northern Cambria H.S.) added 15 points in the win, while sophomore F Devin McGrath (Robinson Twp., PA/Our Lady of Sacred Heart H.S.) recorded a "double" double with 11 pointsand a game-high 14 rebounds. For Waynesburg, junior PG Hannah Hunter (Hopewell, PA/Hopewell H.S.) poured in a game-high 24 points and added a team-best eight rebounds in defeat, while Jessi Drayer (Waterford, OH/Waterford H.S.) added 10 markers.

## Semifinal Game #2 - Crestview Hills, Ky. #1 THOMAS MORE 66, #5 Grove City 54

After leading by just two (25-23) at the half, the top-ranked Saints came out of the locker room firing on all cylinders and built a 23-point advantage (57-34) with 6:46 to play before a late Wolverine run closed the final gap. Thomas More boasted another balanced scoring attack, led by sophomore G Chelsea Tolliver (Morning View, KY/Simon Kenton H.S.) with 12 points. Allison Long (Hebron, KY/Conner H.S.) and Katie Kees (Cincinnati, OH/Mother of Mercy H.S.) added 11 and 10 points, respectively, to give TMC an opportunity to play for for an unprecedented fifth consecutive PAC title on Saturday. For Grove City, senior F Christine Slater (Aliquippa, PA/Center H.S.) tallied game-best totals of 24 points and nine rebounds in the loss, while sophomore G Leah Gibson (North Canton, OH/Hoover H.S.) added 12 points for GCC.
