#### PAC TOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND GAMES - 2/25/03 First Round Game #1 - Waynesburg, Pa. #3 WAYNESBURG 52, #6 Thiel 44

The Tomcats eyed an opening round upset by taking a 21-19 lead into halftime, but the Yellow Jackets rallied to outscore Thiel 33-23 in the second half to earn the win. Freshman G Candice Eyerman (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) was the lone Waynesburg player to reach double figures in scoring with 10 points, while freshman G/F Tina Ramer (Hadley, PA/Commodore Perry H.S.) and sophomore G Michelle Collins (Steubenville, OH/Steubenville H.S.) grabbed 13 and 11 rebounds, respectively. Freshman G Heather Abate (Kittanning, PA/Ford City H.S.) and junior G Amanda Swanson (Clearfield, PA/Clearfield H.S.) added 11 and 10 points, respectively, in the loss for Thiel.

## First Round Game #2 - New Wilmington, Pa. #4 WESTMINSTER 76, #5 Bethany 60

The Bison saw their string of four consecutive PAC women's basketball titles come to an end, as Westminster (playing in its first-ever PAC Tournament) outscored Bethany 40-24 in the second half to break open a 36-36 halftime tie. Senior F Samor Himes (Irwin, PA/Penn-Trafford H.S.) bucketed a game-high 24 points for Westminster. Senior G Jennifer Petures (Monaca, PA/Center H.S.) added 15 markers, while sophomore F Erica Tallo (Oakdale, PA/West Allegheny H.S.) added a double-double with 14 points and a game-high 12 rebounds. Junior C Kelley Richardson (Follansbee, WV/Brooke H.S.) recorded team-high totals of 23 points and nine rebounds for the Bison, while sophomore G Nikki Babik (Johnstown, PA/Westmont-Hilltop H.S.) added 16 markers off the bench.

#### PACTOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL GAMES - 2/28/03 Semifinal Game #1 - Washington, Pa.

The Lady Wolverines advanced to the PAC championship

game by taking an eight-point halftime lead (43-35) and holding off a late Waynesburg rally which cut the GCC lead to three points (64-61) with 3:09 to play. From there, Grove City outscored the Yellow Jackets 13-6 the rest of the way to clinch the semifinal victory. GCC was led by sophomore G Abby Moose (New Wilmington, PA/Mercer H.S.) with game-high totals of 25 points (including four three-pointers), five assists and three steals. Senior G Cara Denniston (Grove City, PA/Grove City H.S.) added 14 for the Lady Wolverines. Waynesburg was paced by freshman G Candice Eyerman (Cranberry Twp., PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) with 21 points on seven three-pointers, while freshman F Tina Ramer (Hadley, PA/Commodore Perry H.S.) added a double-double with 18 points and 12 boards.

Semifinal Game #2 - Washington, Pa.

#1 WASHINGTON & JEFFERSON 81, #4 Westminster 77 Westminster appeared poised to post an upset of the top-seeded and nationally-ranked Presidents, as the Lady Titans held a 67-61 lead with 4:11 to play. However, W&J responded with a 10-0 run to take a 71-67 lead with 2:15 left. The Presidents then hit all eight free throws in the final 1:17 to advance to the championship against Grove City. Junior G Shawndra McDonald (Houston, TX/Westfield H.S.) led all scorers with 26 points while adding game-high totals of seven assists and six steals for W&J, while freshman G Leigh Sulkowski (Upper St. Clair, PA/Upper St. Clair H.S.) scored 23 points and junior G Rachel Armitage (Butler, PA/Butler H.S.) added 12 markers off the bench. All five Westminster starters scored in double figures, led by senior G Jennifer Petures (Monaca, PA/Center H.S.) with 18 points.

#### PAC CHAMPIONSHIP - Washington, Pa. - 3/1/03 #1 WASHINGTON & JEFFERSON 72, #2 Grove City 63

The Presidents, ranked #25 in the nation and #1 in the Great Lakes Region, captured their fourth PAC women's basketball title and their first since the 1997-98 season with a nine-point home win over Grove City. The two teams were tied 37-37 at the half, but W&J outscored GCC 35-26 in the decisive second half. The Presidents were paced by freshman G/F Amanda Stanonik (North Versailles, PA/East Allegheny H.S.), who came off the bench to post career-high totals of 23 points (on 9-of-11 shooting) and nine rebounds. Senior F Amy Strosnider (Waynesburg, PA/Waynesburg Central H.S.) added 10 markers for W&J in the win. Junior F Leigh LeGare (Copperas Cove, TX/Copperas Cove H.S.) and senior F Christy Faller (Ijamsville, MD/Urbana H.S.) led the Lady Wolverines with 16 and 14 points, respectively.
