PACTOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND GAMES - 2/24/04 First Round Game #1 - Washington, Pa.

#3 WASHINGTON & JEFFERSON 85, #6 Thiel 69

The Tomcats eyed an opening round upset as they trailed the Presidents by a single point (31-30) at the half. However, defending PAC champion Washington & Jefferson took command by outscoring Thiel 54-39 in the second period. Four W&J players reached double figures in the win, led by sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski (Upper St. Clair, PA/Upper St. Clair H.S.) with 28 points, while senior G Shawndra McDonald (Houston, TX/Westfield H.S.) added 20 points and a game-high nine assists. Thiel was paced by freshman guard Nicole Valentino (Sharon, PA/Sharon H.S.), who bucketed a game-high 29 points in the loss.

First Round Game #2 - Grove City, Pa.

#4 GROVE CITY 61, #5 Waynesburg 43

The Lady Wolverines raced to a 13-point halftime lead (34-21), then held on to post the opening round home win over the Yellow Jackets. Junior G Abby Moose (New Wilmington, PA/Mercer H.S.) led the victors with 18 points, including four three-pointers, while classmates Rachel Romance (East Springfield, PA/Northwestern H.S.) and Sandy O'Keefe (Perry, OH/Perry H.S.) added 11 and 10 points, respectively. Sophomore G Candice Eyerman (Cranberry Township, PA/Seneca Valley H.S.) scored a team-high 11 points in the loss for Waynesburg, while sophomore G Rachel Dillon (Erie, PA/McDowell H.S.) dished out six assists.

PACTOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL GAMES - 2/27/04 Semifinal Game #1 - Bethany, W.Va.

#3 Washington & Jefferson 55, #2 Westminster 53
W&J led 21-19 at the half and led by as many as 15 in the

second half, before a Westminster rally capped by a three-pointer tied the game at 53-53 in the final minute. The Presidents then worked the clock until the final seconds, culminating with sophomore G/F Lauren Slampak (Uniontown, PA/Laurel Highlands H.S.) hitting the game-winner with 1.3 seconds to play. Sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski (Upper St. Clair, PA/Upper St. Clair H.S.) led the way for Washington & Jefferson with a game-high 23 points. For the Lady Titans, junior G Alyson Gasper (Beaver Falls, PA/Blackhawk H.S.) had a team-high 15 points, while junior F Erica Tallo (Oakdale/West Allegheny H.S.) added 14 points and a game-high 14 rebounds in the loss.

Semifinal Game #2 - Bethany, W.Va.

#1 BETHANY 59, #4 Grove City 54

The Bison advanced to the PAC Championship by taking a 29-22 halftime lead against the Lady Wolverines, then holding on in the second half for the victory. Senior C Kelley Richardson (Follansbee, WV/Brooke H.S.) paced Bethany with game-high totals of 22 points and 16 rebounds, while junior G Nikki Babik (Johnstown, PA/Westmont-Hilltop H.S.) added 10 markers. Grove City, which had four of its five starters foul out of the game, was led by junior G Abby Moose (New Wilmington, PA/Mercer H.S.) and junior C Sandy O'Keefe (Perry, OH/Perry H.S.) with 20 and 18 points, respectively.

PAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - Bethany, W.Va. - 2/28/04

#1 BETHANY 83, #3 Washington & Jefferson 74

The Bison led by just two points (46-44) at the half, but outscored the Presidents 37-30 in the second half as Bethany captured its fifth PAC women's basketball title in the past six years. Senior C Kelley Richardson (Follansbee, WV/Brooke H.S.) led Bethany with 22 points and 14 rebounds, while junior Nikki Babik (Johnstown, PA/Westmont-Hilltop H.S.) and freshman Sherelle Vossen (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) each added 15 and sophomore Renee Shehady (Pittsburgh, PA/Oakland Catholic H.S.) posted 13. For W&J, sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski (Upper St. Clair, PA/Upper St. Clair H.S.) scored a game-high 31 points, including 26 in the first half. Sophomore G/F Lauren Slampak (Uniontown, PA/Laurel Highlands H.S.) was the only other President to reach double figures in scoring with 12 points.
