College in Williamsport, Pa. ... The Tomcats finished 1-3 at the event a year ago ... Freshman 125 pound **Rob Miller** has had a fantastic start to his collegiate career, opening with a 16-2 record during first semester competition.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



The Presidents posted a 3-3 record in dual meets and placed seventh of eight teams at the Florida Citrus Tournament during the holiday break period ... Sophomores 174-pounder Eric Monday and heavy-

weight Josh Brewer led the Presidents in the tournament with third-place finishes ... Monday recorded a 4-1 record, including a 2-1 victory over Case Western Reserve's B.J. Greenman in the third-place match ... He opened the tournament with a fall (6:01) against **D.J. Lombardo** of Ursinus. ... Brewer notched a pair of wins to advance to the semifinals, but lost to topseeded Derrick Bendau of John Carroll by fall (2:15) to move into the consolation bracket ... He responded with two victories, including a fall (4:00) over Wilmington's Adam Slayers in the thirdplace match ... Freshman 157-pounder Keagan Donnan recorded a perfect 3-0 record on Sunday in the dual tournament ... He combined to outscore his opponents by a 21-9 margin ... In the W&J Quad on Saturday, freshman 141-pounder Nicholas Centra notched a 3-0 record to lead the Presidents ... He earned decision victories by scores of 17-10 and 9-0, while also collecting one fall (6:15) ... Senior 184pounder Chris Price also picked up three victories ... He earned one forfeit and one fall (1:40) before claiming a 9-3 decision ... Monday and Brewer collected two wins each.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Over the holiday break, Waynesburg competed at the 27th-annual Ohio Northern Inviational team and the Washing-

ton & Jefferson duals ... The Yellow Jackets placed 18th overall at the ONU Invitational with junior Jake Benczo and senior LR **Neubauer** leading the team with two wins each in their respective weight classes ... Benczo claimed a pair of victories in the 165-pound bracket, including an 11-9 decision ... Neubauer earned both his wins in the 32-wrestler field of the heavyweight bracket via pinfall ... The Yellow Jackets then suffered three losses in dual action at the W&J duals Saturday ... Against the host Presidents, the Yellow Jackets suffered a 39-6 loss in PAC action ... Benczo posted a 6-0 decision at the 165-pound match, while in the heavyweight bout, Neubauer registered a 4-1 decision ... In its second action of the afternoon, Waynesburg dropped a 40-6 match to Washington & Lee University ... Freshman Zane Bachert earned the lone victory in the match for the Yellow Jackets with his pin fall in the heavyweight bout ... The Yellow Jackets concluded the dual meet with a 41-6 loss to Gettysburg College ... Freshman Josh Boyle claimed the lone victory for Waynesburg with a pin fall in 133-pound match.
