Matches will begin at 9 a.m. each day ... The Tomcats are ranked 22nd in the latest National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Division III team poll.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Pensacola Christian took advantage of three Washington & Jefferson forfeits to notch a 33-9 victory over the Presidents on Wednesday evening at the Henry Memorial Center ... Sophomore heavyweight Phil McCormick picked up the lone W&J victory after breezing to an 11-0 win over PCC freshman Chuck Roberts ... Senior 174-pounder Matt Smith earned the other six W&J points with a forfeit win ... Smith and freshman 125pounder Jacob Habel won all four of their matches on Saturday at the North-South Duals ... Smith won two matches by fall and also garnered a major decision victory, while Habel pinned Bridgewater State's Eric Rosado and also notched two major decisions ... Junior 133-pounder Steve Schlauch posted a 3-1 mark in the tournament ... He had a 4-2 victory over Western New England's Jeff Murdock in his first match of the day.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets posted a 1-3 record during semester break in dual meet competition, including a split in a pair of matches against Pensacola Christian (Fla.) ... Waynesburg lost to the Eagles by one, 20-19, at Waynesburg after forfeiting two weight classes and losing two other matches via major decisions ... Two days later Waynesburg and Pensacola Christian met again, this time in a triangular match at Mt. Union, and the Jackets would be victorious, 36-18 ... Ken Laird, Nick Dlugonski and Chris Van **Dine** posted two wins in their respective weight classes against Pensacola Christian ... In the match against the host Raiders, Tyler Allen, Daniel Goulart and James Weishaar posted wins ... Laird continued his success at the Muskingum Invitational, as he placed first at 149-lbs. with a perfect 3-0 record ... A pair of Waynesburg wrestlers in the 174 lb. bracket placed, including Nick Dlugonski in third ... In the heavyweight division, the Yellow Jackets featured a trio of wrestlers battling for placing position ... Heavyweight Daniel Goulart finished fourth, followed by teammates Mike Walker and L.R. Neubauer in fifth and sixth place, respectively.
