PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

RYAN WILES

Washington & Jefferson College

Sophomore - 197 pounds Lower Burrell, Pa./Burrell H.S.

Wiles posted a perfect 3-0 record for Washington & Jefferson at the North-South Duals at MIT, winning all three matches by fall. His three fals came in a total time of 3:43, including pinning **Brian Meyers** of Western New England in 41 seconds.

Also nominated was sophomore 165-pounder **Aaron Gibbs** of Thiel.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat wrestling team competed against some of the toughest Division III programs in the nation at the Budd Whitehill Division III Duals, hosted by Lycoming College in Williamsport ... Thiel wrested their way to a 3-2 mark at the duals and defeated a top 25 squad along the way ... Twelve of the 20 competing teams came into the Whitehill Duals ranked in the top 30 in the latest Division III Team rankings ... Thiel perhaps had the toughest start to the duals, opening on Friday morning against the top-seeded and fourthranked New Jersey ... The Tomcats fell 44-0 to the Lions in the first-round matchup ... The Tomcats biggest win of the weekend came on Friday afternoon, defeating ninth-seeded and 23rd-ranked Kings 28-21 ... They improved to 2-1 in opening-day action after defeating Scranton 22-17 in their third-round match ... Sophomore Aaron Gibbs went 2-0 during the opening day at 165 pounds, picking two wins by fall in the process ... Gibbs defeated King's Jason Mushinski (2:59) and Scranton's **Tim Grover** (1:16) ... Senior **Chris** Brown went 2-1between 141 and 133 pounds and freshman Nic Engler also went 2-1 at the 197-pound weight class, recording a pair of pinfall victories ... The Tomcats opened Saturday against seventh-seeded and 19thranked Lycoming ... Despite Gibbs recording an 11-3 major decision against Clint Swartz for his third-straight win, the Tomcats fell to the Warriors 39-4 ... Thiel finished strong, defeating Rochester Institute of Technology 31-22 in their final match of the weekend ... Gibbs won his fourth match of the weekend and recorded his third pinfall win by defeating Sean Durst (1:46).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson won two matches, but dropped two others on Saturday at the North-South Duals hosted by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology ... Sophomore 197-pounder Ryan Wiles won all three of his matches by pinfall ... He pinned Brian Meyers of Western New England in 41 seconds, Dwayne Ernst of Johnson & Wales in 1:53 and Jonathan Tipermas of MIT in 1:09 ... Sophomore heavyweight Ken McDonald recorded a 3-1 mark with three falls in a total time of 2:38 ... Senior 141-pounder Byron Johnson also notched a 3-1 record in the tournament, highlighted by a technical fall win in 4:12 over Western New England's Dan Staple ... Junior 174-pounder Matt Smith racked up a pair of wins, defeating Alex Cutting of MIT by fall (3:42) and edging Wesleyan's Dan Case, 7-2 ... Senior 157pounder Chris Day also had two wins ... Day defeated Western New England's Eric Ahnrud, 4-0, and MIT's Alan Anderson, 6-1 ... W&J also scored a 34-18 exhibition win over Pensacola Christian on Wednesday.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

As hosts of a triangular match on Tuesday night, the Waynesburg dropped both its matches versus visiting Mount Union and Pensacola Christian ... Two pivotal falls in the lightweights propelled Mount Union to a decisive 34-10 win over Waynesburg, while Pensacola Christian rode two pins in heavyweight bouts for a 30-25 win ... Against Mount Union, Waynesburg (1-6) fell victim to two falls at 133 and 141, and sophomore Mike Olem losing a 10-1 major decision at 125 to Richie Schmock ... The winners for Waynesburg over Mount Union included senior Matt Queen at 165, freshman Steve Wagers at 197, and freshman John Anthony Smith gutting out a 2-1 double-overtime win over Luke Latham in the heavyweight bout ... Wagers absorbed the decisive loss at 197 for Waynesburg in its defeat to Pensacola, as Adam Hicks pinned him at 2:36 ... The Jackets led 25-24 entering the bout, counting a would-be forfeit for the heavyweight bout ... Olem, with a 15-1 major decision win at 125, joined senior J.R. Fidler and sophomore Ken Laird as winners in bouts against the Eagles.
