PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

MATT SMITH

Washington & Jefferson College Sophomore - 174 pounds Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Smith posted a perfect 5-0 record during the week with three pinfall victories and two technical falls, as Washington & Jefferson was 3-2 in dual meet competition. His five points against Pensacola Christian keyed a comefrom-behind win for the Presidents. He then posted three pins in four matches at the Ursinus North-South Duals.

Also nominated was junior 197-pounder T.J. Albright of Thiel, and senior heavyweight Chris Pierce of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished 2-2 at last weekend's North-South Duals, hosted by Ursinus College ... The Tomcats earned a 19-15 win over M.I.T. to open the Duals with senior 149pounder Steve Dedrick picking up a pinfall victory over Greg Fonder in 1:35 ... Trinity handed the Tomcats their first shutout of the season, defeating Thiel 48-0 ... Behind four pins Thiel bettered Western New England 40-24 ... Senior 133pounder Mark Farrell, freshman 157pounder John Svirbly, junior 184pounder T.J. Albright and freshman 285pounder Mike Young each picked up pinfall victories ... Dedrick recorded a 17-2 technical fall win over WNEC's Eric Ahnrud ... York defeated the Tomcats 39-9 in their final match of the day ... Farrell registered a pinfall win (0:44) over Weber for six of the Tomcats nine points.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Senior 133-pounder Kevin DeJulius and sophomore 174-pounder Matt Smith both recorded victories in all four matches at the Ursinus Duals on Saturday ... DeJulius picked up decision wins over Johns Hopkins and M.I.T. and a victory by fall against Western New England. He also earned a forfeit win in the match versus Wesleyan ... Smith recorded three pinfall victories and added a technical fall win in the loss to Wesleyan ... Juniors 141-pounder Byron Johnson and 197pounder Brad Guinn both posted 3-1 showings ... Johnson garnered his biggest victory of the day with a major decision against M.I.T., while Guinn picked up triumphs in maches versus Western New England, Wesleyan and M.I.T. ... Freshman heavyweight Ryan Wiles pinned freshman **Kevin Grace** at the 1:04 mark to lift Washington & Jefferson to a 29-25 come-from-behind victory over Pensacola Christian on Wednesday evening ... PCC held a 19-12 advantage after six matches before Smith earned a major decision to bring W&J to within two points, 19-17 ... Guinn picked up a key victory by fall at 197 pounds to close the Presidents to within two points at 25-23, setting up Wiles' heroics in the final match.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets struggled during the week losing their fifth-straight dual match ... A win on the home opener slipped away, as the Jackets lost 25-20 to visiting Pensacola Christian College Thursday ... The most pivotal and closely-contested match came at 197 pounds, as Waynesburg's Jaime Pradera lost an 8-4 decision to Brandon Noble ... The match clinched the win for the Eagles (6-4), making their annual northeast trip ... Winners for Waynesburg included Chris Vicente, Bryan Patnesky, and Chris Pierce, while Mike Olem claimed a forfeit at 125 ... Vicente won a major decision over Ben Katshor, 13-1, in the 141pound bout, as he improved his overall season record to 15-5 ... Patnesky also gutted out a major decision, 19-7, over Joel Porcher in the 174-pound bout ... Pierce had no problems with Kevin Grace in the heavyweight bout, as he recorded the pin just 20 seconds in ... Waynesburg dropped two dual meets Tuesday in non-conference action at Mount Union to the host Purple Raiders and to Mount St. Joseph's ... The Jackets lost to Mount St. Joseph's, 22-18, in the first match ... Kenneth Laird and John Maybury registered wins at 149 and 165, respectively, while the Jackets benefited from two forfeits ... Laird won an 11-7 decision over the Lions' Sidney Bostic, and Maybury won a 3-0 decision over Eric Pace ... The Purple Raiders cruised to a 33-9 win over the Jackets ... Vicente and Pierce won the Jackets lone matches.
