Drummond and Cressley each posted perfect 3-0 records to capture invitational titles at 141 and 197 pounds, respectively, at the Washington & Lee Invitational in Lexington, Va., on Saturday. In his first match as a Yellow Jacket, Drummond (not pictured) won by pin fall in just 41 seconds in the opening round. After a semifinal win against a PAC rival from W&J, he posted a 9-1 major decision over Rick Russell of Scranton in the title match. Cressley posted a pair of falls to advance to the championship, where he recorded a 12-4 major decision over Pat Truster of Mount St. Joseph.

Also nominated was freshman 125-pounder **Rob Miller** of Thiel.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats



The Thiel wrestling squad bounced back from a 0-2 start on Friday to finish with a 2-2 mark at Lycoming College's Budd White-hill Duals ... The event

featured a 20-team pool that included ten of the top 30 squads in NCAA Division III, according to the latest Brute/Adidas NWCA Poll ... Thiel suffered a 41-0 loss to top seed and eighth-ranked SUNY-Cortland in round one and was dealt a 23-16 loss by ninth seed and 25th-ranked Wilkes University in round four action ... The Tomcats posted a 29-18 victory against Rochester Institute of Technology to conclude Friday's action in round seven and returned Saturday to post a 23-21 victory over SUNY-Oswego in round 10 ... Freshman 125-pound Rob Miller went 3-1 at the event, improving his season overall record to 19-3 ... Sophomore 174-pound Jordan Gaudette also finished 3-1, while freshman 197-pound Cris Gault and junior Andrew Riddle each finished with a pair of victories.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



Washington & Jefferson College freshman Alex Cressley won the 197-pound championship to help the Presidents place second of seven teams on Saturday at the Washington and Lee Invitational in Virginia ...

Cressley was W&J's Ione individual champion after sweeping three matches ... He opened with a victory by fall over W&L's Nick Nox in 2:44 and then pinned the Generals' John Christopher in 6:52 ... Cressley earned a 12-4 major decision over MSJ's Pat Truster in the championship bout ... Senior 184-pounder Chris Price, sophomore 174-pounder Eric Monday and freshman 133-pounder Brandon Samson all posted second-place showings ... Price opened with a 6-3 semifinal win over W&L's Kirk Adamson, but fell to Chad Craft of Mt. St. Joseph by an 8-5 margin in the championship match ... Samson defeated Logan Davis of So. Virginia in the first round, 13-2, and then topped W&L's David Shubick by a 6-3 margin in the semifinals ... MSJ's Eric Mever then claimed the title with a 7-0 triumph ... Monday edged Scranton's Kevin Digiulio, 7-2, in his first match and then blanked Rob Terrin of Washington and Lee in the semifinals, 5-0 ... Justin Fitch of Muhlenberg won the title with a 3-2 victory in the finals ... Sophomore heavyweight Josh Brewer took third place.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Led by a first-place finish by newcomer Leonard Drummond, the Yellow Jackets finished in sixth place at the Washington & Lee

Invitational Saturday afternoon ... Drummond posted a perfect 3-0 record at 141-pounds to earn medalist honors ... He posted an impressive debut victory, winning by pin fall in just 41 seconds, before claiming the title with a 9-1 major decision in the championship match ... At 133pounds, freshman Josh Boyle earned a third-place finish with a 3-1 mark after losing his first bout ... In the consolation quarterfinals he posted a 10-1 major decision before posting a 4-2 overtime win in the semifinals ... In the third-place match, he claimed a 3-2 decision victory ... In the heavyweight bracket, senior LR Neubauer finished in fourth place with a 2-2 record to improve his team-leading win total to a career-high 10 ... Each of his victories at the W&L Invitational came via pin fall (5:21, 4:46) ... Freshman Kevin Walsh posted his first career pin fall at 157 pounds to round out the Waynesburg wrestlers who earned a victory at the seven-team invitational.
