PAC Wrestler of the Week

NICK SHANNON - Thiel College

Sophomore - 285 lbs. Middleburg Heights, Ohio/Midpark H.S.

Shannon went 4-1 for the Tomcats last week, including capturing the 285-pound championship at the Fifth Annual Washington & Jefferson Invitational on Jan. 12. He pinned Wallace of SUNY-Brockport in 3:32 and then went on to defeat St. Louis of SUNY-Brockport 3-1 to advance to the championship match. In an 8-7 overtime decision, Shannon defeated Pennise of SUNY-Brockport. Shannon earlier went 1-1 for the MatCats in their tri-meet against Davidson and Duquesne on Jan. 7.

Also nominated was 197-pound senior **Tony Boone** of Washington & Jefferson and 141-pound senior **Matt Courtwright** of Waynesburg.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished sixth at the Fifth Annual Washington & Jefferson Invitational last weekend... The MatCats totaled 25.0 total team points, paced by Nick Shannon, who won the championship at the 285-pound weight class ... The MatCats will travel back to Washington, Pa. this Tuesday, Jan. 15 to go up against the Presidents in a dual meet... Thiel will then hit the road for Columbus, Ohio to compete in the 2002 Cliff Keen/NWCA National Dual on Jan. 19-20...Thiel will be among 17 schools competing for the Division III title...Among the 17 will be defending 2001 NCAA champions Augsburg, Buena Vista, The College of New Jersey and Upper Iowa.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

In Wednesday's win over Pensacola Christian, the Presidents trailed 16-0 after the first three matches of the evening, but fought back to win each of the next five bouts in claiming the nine-point win ... W&J freshman 165-pounder Aaron Gibbs started the rally by defeating Joel Porcher at the 2:22 mark by pinfall ... Freshman 174-pounder Matt Smith matched Gibbs with a pinfall victory over Matt Fitch at the 3:29 mark ... After a 9-3 victory by senior Wes Koteski at 184, senior 197-pounder Tony Boone pinned PCC's Chad Lasher in 1:02 to give the Presidents a 21-16 lead ... On Saturday, Gibbs posted the squad's top performance by placing second at 165 ... The loss was his first of the season and he now stands at 16-1 with 12 pins ... Koteski, Boone and junior 133-pounder Kevin DeJulius all posted third place finishes in the invitational.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg wrestling team dropped a 38-18 home decision to Pensacola Christian before finishing seventh in the Washington & Jefferson Wrestling Invitational last week ...
