Murphy posted a 3-1 record for the Tomcats last weekend at the Lycoming Budd Whitehill Duals in Williams-



port, Pa. He earned his 100th career victory with a 22-7 technical fall against Silas Bowerman of Norwich in the Tomcats' 27-25 win Saturday. Murphy is now 19-6 on the season.

Also nominated sophomore 174-pounder **Patrick Wilson** of Washington & Jefferson and freshman 197-pounder **Brandon Miller** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats



The Tomcats went 1-3 at last weekend's Budd Whitehill Duals, hosted by Lycoming College ... This year's Whitehill Duals featured 20 teams from across the nation

and nine squads that are ranked in the top 30 in the latest Brute-Adidas National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) rankings ... There were also 20 individuals participating that ranked in the top eight in their respective weight classes ... Thiel started 0-3 on Friday, falling to Ithaca (32-10), Messiah (19-19, criteria G) and Rhode Island (26-14) ... The Tomcats picked up a 27-25 comefrom-behind win against Norwich Saturday ... Highlighting Saturday's win against Norwich was senior Corey Murphy, who registered his 100th career win with the Tomcats ... Murphy entered Saturday's match against Norwich with a 99-43 career mark and earned a 22-7 technical fall win over Silas Bowerman at 165 to improve to 100-43 overall and 19-6 on the season ... Senior heavyweight Kyle Brown went 4-0 over the weekend, improving to 27-5 on the season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



The Presidents placed fifth out of 14 teams on Saturday at the Washington and Lee Invitational in Lexington, Va.... W&J was led by sophomore Patrick Wilson and freshman Shaun Yackey who both posted sec-

ond-place finishes in their respective weight classes ... Wilson earned second place at 174 pounds with wins over Joe Gunter of Maryville and Justin Fitch of Muhlenberg ... He pinned Gunter in 53 seconds and edged Fitch by a 7-6 margin ... Washington and Lee's Jesse Sataloff defeated Wilson, 11-2, in the championship bout ... Yackey opened the 149-pound bracket with an 8-3 victory over Muhlenberg's Joe Decampo ... He then earned an 18-7 major decision against James Gettinger of Johns Hopkins before falling to Scranton's Donnell Young, 8-5, in the championship match ... Junior 157pounder Pete Elers was W&J's only other placewinner after grabbing third ... He defeated Maryville's Jan Hoepper by fall (1:41) in the opening match, but dropped a 5-2 decision to Peter Rose of Southern Virginia ... Elers bounced back to edge Mike Guenther of Scranton, 5-1, and then bested Tim Manson of West Liberty, 4-0, in the third-place match.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



The Waynesburg College wrestling team competed in the eight-team Washington & Lee tournament on Saturday at the Warner

Center in Lexington, Va. ... Freshman Brandon Miller registered a third-place finish and a 3-1 record at the 197-lbs. weight class ... In his opening bout, he posted a pin over Mike Byrnes of Scranton before losing his second match ... Miller then recorded a pin fall victory in just 1:03 before winning the consolation championship match by a 3-2 decision ... With his three wins on Saturday, Miller is now tied for the team lead with eight wins, including four via pin fall ... Freshman Abdul Yusuff was the only other Yellow Jacket wrestler to post a win on Saturday, moving up to the 141-lbs. weight class for the first time this season ... Yusuff registered a 10-3 decision over Brady Miller from Maryville for his lone win ... Muhlenberg won the invitational title with 86 points, followed by Johns Hopkins (77.5) and the host Generals (75.5). Waynesburg finished in eighth place with a score of 10 points.
