**Washington & Jefferson College** 

Senior - 197 pounds Lower Burrell, Pa./Burrell H.S.

Wiles captured the 197-pound title this weekend at the Washington & Lee Invitational, posting his second straight W&L invitational title and the third of his collegiate career. He opened the tournament with a 7-3 win over Niels Madsen of VMI before pinning Dave Rohan of Scranton in the semifinals in 2:10. In the championship match, he recorded a 15-5 major decision over Trevor Needham of Scranton.

# PAC WRESTLING NOTES

## **Thiel Tomcats**



The Tomcats went 2-2 at last weekend's Budd Whitehill Duals, hosted by Lycoming College ... Thiel split during the opening day, losing to The College of New Jersey, currently ranked

sixth in the nation, 30-9 to start the day, but finished with a come-from-behind 16-15 win over Rhode Island College ... On Saturday the Tomcats fell to ninth-ranked York College 35-12, but once again battled back to pick up a 25-12 victory over 17th-ranked Johnson & Wales University in the consolation round ... Thiel picked up five wins against Rhode Island, but none was more important than Kyle Brown's win at 285 ... His 10-3 decision over Andrew Algarin erased a 15-13 lead for Rhode Island to give the Tomcats the 16-15 victory ... Johnson & Wales used three-straight major decisions to take a 12-0 lead after the first three bouts ... Starting with junior Mike Kemble's 0:45 pin of Robert Doherty at 149, the Tomcats rattled off seven straight victories in posting the 25-12 win ... Brown finished 4-0 on the weekend with a 5-2 decision over Chris Bell ... Junior 165pound Corey Murphy finished 3-0 on the weekend and defeated fourth-ranked Steve Martell of JWU 2-1 in the 165-pound bout.

Senior Ryan Wiles captured the 197-pound championship to help W&J place fourth out of 12 teams at the Washington & Lee Wrestling Invitational Saturday ... Wiles opened the tournament with a 7-3 victory

over VMI's Niels Madsen and then pinned Scranton's Dave Rohan in the semifinals in a time of 2:10 ... Wiles earned his second-straight individual championship at the Invitational and the third of his career after posting a 15-5 major decision against Trevor Needham of Scranton ... Freshman heavyweight Mitch Tenney placed second in his first collegiate action, while sophomores 133-pounder Jacob Habel and 149pounder Pete Elers both placed third in their respective brackets ... Tenney earned a 4-2 decision in the opening round and then added a fall in 2:38 ... Habel defeated Scranton's Ryan McDaniel, 4-2, in the opening round before falling to Cumberland's Xavier Gomez in the semifinals by a 12-5 margin ... Habel bounced back to place third after again knocking off McDaniel following a 13-5 major decision ... Elers picked up a 46-second fall versus VMI's Robert Taylor in the guarterfinals, but lost to W&L's Peter Lawrence, 6-2, in the semifinals. Elers then recorded a technical fall (5:00) versus Washington & Lee's Eric Gagne in the third-place match ... Junior heavyweight Phil McCormick posted a 1-2 record in the tournament as he picked up his victory in the consolation quarterfinals, defeating Southern Virginia's Joshua Bake, 6-1 ... W&J returns to the mats Wednesday as it travels to Pittsburgh to compete against D-I Duquesne at the Palumbo Center.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Waynesburg lost its lone match of the weekend in Cincinnati to host College of Mount St. Joseph, 30-3 ... Senior **Ken Laird** posted the lone Yellow Jacket victory during the match with a 9-2 decision ... Laird now is just one

victory shy of 100 for his career and is within reach of the program record for career wins (108), which is held by **Mark Jenkins**, who was a four-time All-American ... Laird also leads the team this season with a 20-9 overall record.
