Freshman - 157 pounds Wilmington, Del./Brandywine H.S.

Council was a perfect 4-0 at the Budd Whitehill Division III duals, hosted by Lycoming College this weekend. He opened the tournament with a win by fall (6:43) against Ithaca's **KC Beach** and followed that up with decisions against Norwich's **Dan Whelan** (8-4) and Rhode Island's **Colin Smith** (14-5) before recording a major decision victory (11-5) over SUNY-Oswego's **Jarrett Mills**. Council is 15-6 this season, 6-0 in dual meet competition.

Also nominated was junior 197-pounder **Ryan Wiles** of Washington & Jefferson and junior 149-pounder **Ken Laird** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel College wrestling team was winless this weekend at the Budd Whitehill division III Duals, hosted by Lycoming College ... On Friday the Tomcats fell in Round 1 to second-seeded Ithaca College 37-12, fell in Round 4 to Norwich 28-16 and in Round 7 to Rhode Island 24-16 ... On Saturday they posted a loss in Round 10 against SUNY-Oswego 19-23 ... Freshman 157-pound Brandon Council wrestled to a perfect 4-0 mark over the weekend ... Council opened the tournament with a win by fall (6:43) against Ithaca's KC Beach and followed that up with decisions against Norwich's Dan Whelan (8-4) and Rhode Island's Colin Smith (14-5) on Friday ... On Saturday he recorded a major decision victory (11-5) over SUNY-Oswego's Jarrett Mills ... Junior 285-pound Kyle Brown posted a 3-1 overall mark ... Brown earned a major decision against Jeremy Calkins of Oswego (9-1) and recorded a pair of forfeit victories.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson junior Ryan Wiles claimed the 197-pound title at the Washington and Lee Wrestling Invitational to help lead the Presidents to a sixth-place finish out of 12 teams on Saturday at the Warner Center in Lexington, Virginia ... Scranton won the tournament with 68 points. Division I VMI placed second with 59 points followed by Pensacola Christian (55.5), Cumberland (51.5), Maryville (40), W&J (37), W&L (32), VMI "B" (14.5), Maryville "B" (13), Southern Virginia (5), Scranton "B" (2.5) and W&L "B" (2) ... Wiles opened the tournament with a 19-7 major decision over VMI 's Patrick Schraft and then won the title by pinning Maryville's Jon Shannon in 4:51 ... Senior 174pounder Matt Smith and freshman 125pounder Jacob Habel both placed second in their respective brackets ... After earning a bye, Smith pinned Maryville's Joe Gunther in 2:25 to move into the finals where he was defeated by W&L's Jesup Sataloff by a 14-3 margin ... Habel also opened with a bye and then quickly defeated **Jeremy Adams** of VMI by fall in 26 seconds ... Scranton's Rich Russell posted an 8-1 victory over Habel in the championship bout ... Washington & Jefferson travels to Greenville, Pa., on Wednesday for a 7:00 pm conference match with Thiel.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg traveled to the College of Mt. St. Joseph to take part in the Cincinnati Duals last weekend ... Junior **Ken Laird** was the lone victory in the Yellow Jackets match against Cumberland College, who won 42-6 ... Laird pined his opponent at the 2:37 mark to win his match ... He also won in the Jackets' match against Campbellsville via a 7-5 decision in overtime ... Waynesburg lost to Campbellsville 36-18 ... **Chris Van Dine** and **Daniel Goulart** also posted wins in their respective matches at 184 lbs. and heavyweight, both by forfeits.
