Sophomore - 285 pounds (heavyweight) Meadville, Pa./Meadville H.S.

Brown was a perfect 4-0 on the week for the Tomcats, as he recorded a fall in 4:29 in Thiel's 35-12 PAC win over Washington & Jefferson before going 3-0 at the Case Western Reserve Quad in Cleveland on Saturday.

Also nominated was sophomore 285-pounder **Ken McDonald** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

After posting a convincing 35-12 win against conference foe W&J on Thursday, the Tomcats dropped three straight duals at the Case Western Reserve Quad Meet on Saturday ... The Tomcats fell to Olivet 31-15, Case Western Reserve 27-14 and Mount Union 33-13 ... Against W&J, Thiel claimed seven matches, led by sophomore Kyle Brown, who earned a fall (4:29) over Ken McDonald at 285 ... Despite the Tomcats falling in each of their three matches at the CWRU Quad Meet, Brown improved his overall season record to 9-5 after posting victories in each of his matches ... Sophomore Aaron Gibbs recorded a fall (2:13) in his opening match against Olivet, but an injury against CWRU forced him to default and miss the Mt. Union match ... Gibbs is currently 6-0 on the season ... Against Mt. Union, freshman Corey Murphy pushed his season record to 14-12 after a 7-3 win at 149.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J dropped a 35-12 PAC match to Thiel on Thursday in Washington ... Sophomore 197-pounder Ryan Wiles led W&J with a victory by fall to earn six team points ... Senior 141-pounder Byron Johnson recorded a 3-1 victory, while junior 174-pounder Matt Smith moved up to the 184 class and picked up a 5-4 win ... W&J finished third at Washington and Lee this past Saturday and was led by sophomore heavyweight Ken McDonald, who was the Presidents' lone individual champion ... McDonald won both of his matches by fall in a total time of 3:32 ... Johnson, Smith and senior 157-pounder Chris Day all notched runner-up finishes in their respective weight classes ... Johnson went 2-1 in the tournament, while Smith was edged in the championship bout, 9-8 ... Day earned a 2-1 victory in the semifinals, but dropped a 10-0 decision in the finals ... Freshman 149-pounder Kurt Lorenz dropped his first match of the day, but battled back through the consolation bracket to defeat Scranton's Tim **Simanksy**, 8-7, in the third-place match.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg was off last week and will return to action when it hosts the Waynesburg Alumni Duals at the Rudy Marisa Fieldhouse on Saturday at 9 a.m. ... PAC teams Washington & Jefferson and Thiel, along with Kutztown, RIT, and Muskingum, will compete in dual meets at the event.
