Lohr improved to 23-3 on the season with a 5-0 week for the Yellow Jackets. He went 2-0 in dual matches, beating Ohio Valley's Garrett Wireman by 11-1 major decision and Mercyhurst North East's Evan Dahl by pin in 2:52, and claimed the 149-pound title at Saturday's Waynesburg Invitational. He went 3-0 during the tournament with a win by fall in 1:28 to reach the finals where he beat second-seeded Rocky Barilla of Johns Hopkins by 8-2 decision.

Also nominated was junior 165-pounder **Matt Lowry** of Thiel, and sophomore 149-pounder **Tyler Berger** of Wash. & Jeff.

The Tomcats went 1-3 at Lycoming's Budd Whitehill Duals with a win over Rhode Island College and losses to SUNY Cortland, John Carroll and Trine ... **Matt Lowry** was 3-1 at the tournament with an impressive 7-2 win over Cortland's Jon Conroy, who has been ranked as high as eighth in the national rankings this season ... **Corey Brown** finished 3-1 with a 12-4 major decision over 10th-ranked Travis Drappi of Rhode Island College ... **Alec Miller** was 3-1, including a 3-1 win over Cortland's Troy Sterling, who entered the match with a record of 19-5 ... **Andrew Riddle**, a three-time PAC champion for the Tomcats, went 2-2 while competing for the first time since his 08-09 season ended early with an injury ... In the Tomcats' win over Rhode Island, sophomore heavyweight **Will Ringer** clinched the match with a 5-0 win.

W&J took first place in the Wash. & Lee Invite totaling 79.5 points ... W&J beat out Apprentice School (75.5 points) and NYU (59.0) for the team title ... Four W&J wrestlers earned first-place honors; **Tyler Berger** 149-pounder, 184-pounder **Stefen Firmstone**, 197-pounder **Robbie Mies** and heavyweight **Taylor Potts** ... Mies defended his title from a year ago and now owns three falls in four matches on the Virginia campus ... Mies earned falls in both of his victories, defeating Bodie Grass (WVT) in 1:57 and Steve Massey (NYU) in 1:19 ... Berger picked up a 6-2 decision over Brandon Seeberger (Southern Virginia) before recording a quick fall (0:37) against Brian Ross (W&L) and a 5-1 decision over John Walters (WVT) in the championship match ... Firmstone posted a fall (2:41) against Mark Ward (West Virginia Tech) and defeated Chris Silakoski (Scranton) with a 6-2 decision ... Potts recorded a fall against Luke Genovese (Scranton) in 90 seconds and then won a 9-4 decision over Jeremy Diley (TAS) in the title bout.

It was a busy, but successful week for Waynesburg wrestling, which blew out a pair of dual opponents and won the first annual Waynesburg Invitational ... The Yellow Jackets won 18 of 20 dual bouts during a 45-3 win over Ohio Valley and a 41-6 triumph over Mercyhurst North East, and claimed four individual champions at Saturday's tournament ... Sophomore 125-pounder **Alex Crown**, junior 133-pounder **Rico Borz** and freshman 149-pounder **Luke Lohr** all went 2-0 in dual bouts and won individual championships at their respective weight classes ... All three wrestlers went 5-0 on the week, while freshman **Sam Lombardo** went 4-0 on his way to the 157-pound title at the Waynesburg Invitational ... He claimed three of his victories by first-period falls.
