The Tomcats went 1-1 in non-conference dual meet action last week, falling at Division II Gannon 24-17 on Tuesday before posting a 21-17 victory over visiting

Baldwin-Wallace Saturday afternoon ... Against Gannon, sophomore Ashton Osterberg posted a 15-4 major decision win over Adam Green at 125, followed by freshman Damien Rose's 20-9 win over Brian Yoder at 141 ... Thiel trailed 13-8 after dropping matches at both 149 and 157 before senior Corey Murphy recorded a 10-7 decision over Tony Petrella at 165 ... the Tomcats suffered defeats at 174, 184 and 197 before senior Kyle Brown posted a pin fall win at 285 over Chris Wolski ... Against B-W, Thiel posted three-straight wins to start the match, going up by a 12-0 margin...Osterberg was awarded with a forfeit at 125, followed up by a 6-5 decision by freshman Jeffrey Langdon at 133 ... Rose recorded a 12-7 win over Chris Hamed at 141 ... after a Mo Salem decision over sophomore Anthony Prvonozac at 149, Thiel put together back-to-back wins at 157 and 165 ... Freshman Jake Rohrer tallied a 6-3 decision over Joe Incovaia at 157 before Murphy recorded a 5-2 win over Geno Russo at 165 ... Baldwin-Wallace's Jeremy Feador recorded a pin fall win (1:54) over junior Bo Morrell at 174 to cut the Thiel lead to 18-9 ... Sophomore Andrew Riddle defeated Antonio Campea 3-2 at 184 to push the Tomcat's lead back to 12, 21-9 ... **Paul Berger** posted a 15-0 (7:00) technical fall win over senior Logan Malie at 197 before Bryan Kmetz rebounded late to record a 3-1 win over Brown at 285.

The Yellow Jackets suffered a 34-15 loss to the Saints of Mercyhurst-North East ... Newcomer Nikkien Fauntleroy registered a pin fall in his first collegiate match, defeating James Henderson at 133-lbs ... Waynesburg registered back-to-back victories in the 184 and 197-lbs. bouts ... Junior Nick Dlugonski won via forfeit at 184-lbs., while freshman Brandon Miller used overtime to defeat Ron Dombkowski by an 8-3 count in overtime ... Against the Muskies, Fauntleroy continued to impress in his debut, as he posted a an 11-5 victory over David Rivera at 133-lbs. ... Dlugonsi also recorded his second win of the day, defeating Cody Hopper with a 12-4 major decision in the 184-lbs. bout ... The Yellow Jackets lost the match to Muskingum by a 35-7 margin.
