Junior heavyweight **Kyle Brown** improved to 21-4 on the season with a 4-3 win over seventh-ranked **Bryan Kmetz** ... Kmetz dealt Brown a 3-2 loss earlier in the season.

Washington & Jefferson posted a 2-2 record in dual meet action this week as the Presidents dropped decisions to Division I Duquesne and Muskingum, but earned wins over Waynesburg and Mt. St. Joseph ...

Freshman heavyweight Mitch Tenney was the only President to earn team points versus Duquesne after pinning his opponent in a time of 1:13 ... Freshman 141-pounder David Lewandowski, who went 3-0 in his first collegiate tournament ... Lewandowski opened the day with a 15-0 technical fall win over Waynesburg's Jim Weishaar and then edged Josh Sasfy of Mt. St. Joseph, 6-5 ... He ended his perfect day with a 2-0 decision against Muskingum's Dave Minner ... Sophomore 133-pounder Jacob Habel earned two forfeits and racked up another victory after notching a 9-1 major decision versus Muskingum's Jeremy Hudson ... Tenney earned his lone win of the day when he pinned Waynesburg's L.R. Neubauer in 2:19, while sophomore 149pounder Pete Elers also posted a fall in his only win, defeating MSJ's Jason Ashworth in 1:13 ... Freshman 184pounder Chris Price took down MSJ's Chad Craft for his lone win and freshman Andrew Rose finished with a 1-1 record after recording a 5-1 victory at 165 pounds versus Aaron Gramann in the Muskingum match ... Senior 197-pounder Ryan Wiles rounded out the W&J one-match victors with a 5-1 triumph over Muskingum's Eric Engeldinger.
