PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

MATT SMITH

Washington & Jefferson College

Senior - 174/184 pounds Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Smith was a perfect 5-0 for the Presidents last week, which allowed him to become jus the third W&J wrestler in history to surpass 100 career wins. He posted a fall in 1:19 in the dual with Waynesburg, then was 4-0 with one fall and one major decision at the Ursinus Duals on Saturday.

Also nominated was junior 149-pounder **Mike Kemble** of Thiel and freshman heavyweight **Mike Walker** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat wrestling team posted three wins Saturday as they hosted the Tomcat Quad ... Thiel downed Rochester Institute of Technology 39-13 in round one, Mercyhurst-North East 26-19 in round two and Baldwin-Wallace College 27-12 in round three. (Dual meet and individual matches against Mercyhurst-North East are not counted in overall W-L records due to junior college status) ... The Tomcats registered five wins by fall in the win over RIT ... Freshman 125-pound Brandon Dixon, junior 149-pound Mike Kemble, junior 157-pound Ted Mangan, junior 174pound Aaron Gibbs and sophomore 184pound Nate Santelli each picked up pin fall wins against the Tigers ... Freshman 174-pound Bo Morrell dropped Mercyhurst-North East's James Amsley in 1:25 to earn Thiel's lone win by fall against the Saints ... Sophomore 165pound Carmen Russo and sophomore Matt Zackrajsek each won by major decisions...Kemble was the lone winner by pin fall against Baldwin-Wallace, registering his takedown over Scott Conrath in 1:37.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson senior Matt Smith became the third wrestler in school history to reach 100 career wins during Washington & Jefferson and Waynesburg's 21-21 tie on Wednesday ... Smith pinned Waynesburg sophomore Nick Dlugonski during the 184-pound match in a time of 1:19 ... Kevin DeJuliis '03 is the W&J career leader with 117 wins followed by Wes Koteski '02, who amassed 108 victories ... Smith also increased his school record pinfall total to 52 ... Junior 197-pounder Ryan Wiles also posted a 3-0 victory over junior Chris Van Dine ... Smith and Wiles both won all four of their matches at the Ursinus Duals on Saturday ... Wiles posted three wins by fall .. Smith earned one victory by fall and also garnered one major decision.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets opened PAC action with a tie against Washington & Jefferson ... Freshman heavyweight Daniel Goulart pinned his opponent to force the match to a final 21-21 tie ... The match was split evenly throughout with each team claiming a pair of forfeits and match by decision and pinfall ... The win by Goulart prevented W&J from sweeping the final three bouts to claim match victory, as the Presidents won the previous two weight classes by pinfall and decision ... Goulart's pinfall occurred at the 4:34 mark in the heavyweight match ... Junior co-captain James Weishaar put WC on the scoreboard first with a victory via a 9-4 decision at 133-lbs ... Waynesburg would wrestle W&J again this week at the Ursinus Duals, where the Yellow Jackets split four matches, 2-2, with wins over W&J and Gallaudet (Washington, D.C.) ... Freshman Mike Walker wrestled in the heavyweight position at the duals and claimed four victories, including two pinfalls ... Weishaar and fellow captain Ken Laird posted 3-1 records at Ursinus despite changing weight classes throughout the day ... Tyler Allen and Nick Dlugonski each posted multiple wins as well as the duals.
