PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

JOHN MAYBURY

Waynesburg College

Senior - 174 pounds

Maybury won a pivotal bout at 174 pounds to lead Waynesburg to a 27-20 victory over PAC rival Washington & Jefferson this week, which was the first PAC dual meet win for the Yellow Jackets in four years. Maybury pinned Derek Hoover of W&J in 5:49 to give the Jackets a 24-20 lead.

Also nominated was sophomore 165-pounder **Aaron Gibbs** of Thiel and junior 174-pounder **Matt Smith** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel competed at the Mount Union College Invitational in Alliance, Ohio on Sunday ... The Tomcats finished second in the event with 94 team points, but matches against six of the eight competing teams do not count towards team's overall W-L record or individual W-L records due to them being junior colleges and club teams ... Sophomores **Aaron Gibbs** (165) and **Kyle Brown** (285) claimed individual honors at the event, finishing first in their respective weight classes ... Gibbs was 4-0 at 165 with three wins coming by pinfall before earning an 11-0 major decision in the final round ... The Tomcats will host PAC rival Waynesburg at Rissell-Beeghly Gym on Wednesday (7 p.m.) and Jamestown C.C. on Thursday (7 p.m.) before traveling to Baldwin-Wallace College on Saturday to compete in the John Summa Invitational (10 a.m.).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents dropped a pair of dual meets this past week and saw their overall record drop to 3-8 ... In the loss to the Yellow Jackets on Wednesday, senior 157-pounder **Chris Day** and freshman 149-pounder **Kurt Lorenz**, picked up the team's lone individual victories ... Day racked up a 19-3 major decision over WC's **James Weishaar**, while Lorenz posted an 8-6 win over **Ken Laird** ... Gettysburg ran out to a 23-0 lead and won the first five matches on Sunday in the 11-point win over Washington & Jefferson ... Despite forfeiting two weight classes, the Presidents fought back in the final three matches with three victories by fall ... Junior 174-pounder **Matt Smith** started the rally with a pin over **Aaron Fuchs** in a time of 4:11 and then sophomore 197-pounder **Ryan Wiles** recorded a fall in 1:26 over **Jeff Morgan** ... Sophomore heavyweight **Ken McDonald** rounded out the fall streak with a pin over **Mike Pattanite** in a time of 3:11 ... W&J travels to Berea, Ohio, on Saturday to compete in the John Summa Tournament hosted by Baldwin-Wallace College.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg won its first PAC dual match in four years last Wednesday with a 27-20 win over Washington & Jefferson at home ... The pivotal bout came at 174-pounds when **John Maybury** pinned **Derek Hoover** at 5:49 ... Hoover moved up a weight class to wrestle Maybury, who owns a 3-17 record for the season ... The win gave Waynesburg, counting the two forfeits it yielded at 184 and 197, a 24-20 advantage going into the final heavyweight bout ... **Brian Wolfe** then sealed the win for the Jackets with an 8-2 decision over **Ryan Wiles** ... Other Jackets posting wins were **J.R. Fidler**, who won 7-0 at 133, and **Chris Vicente** who won a 3-1 decision in a double-overtime bout against **Byron Johnson** at 141 ... Waynesburg started the match with a 12-0 advantage courtesy of a forfeit for **Mike Olem** to go with Fidler and Vicente's wins ... **Kurt Lorenz's** overtime victory over **Ken Laird** at 149, and **Chris Day's** technical fall of **James Weishaar** at 157, put W&J within four points, 12-8 ... W&J forfeited to **Matt Queen** at 165 so that Hoover could wrestle Maybury.
