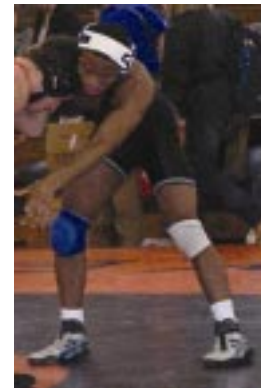

Fauntleroy earned his second PAC Wrestler of the Week honor after posting a perfect 5-0 record for the Yellow Jackets last week. He posted a 15-8 decision in a 45-9 PAC loss to Thiel, then went 4-0 to capture the 133-lb. title at the John Summa Invitational, hosted by Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio. After posting a pin fall (4:43 in the opening round, an 11-4 decision in the quarterfinals and a 15-6 major decision in the semis, Fauntleroy won the weight class with a 5-2 decision over a former 125-lb. All-American.

Also nominated was senior 165-pounder **Corey Murphy** of Thiel, and junior 197-pounder **Zak Jenniches** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats



Thiel earned a dual win against Waynesburg and W&J Thursday before posting a third-place finish at the Summa Invitational, hosted by Baldwin-Wallace, Saturday ... Senior **Corey Murphy** captured the 165-pound championship, leading the Tomcats to their third place with 107.5 points at the 10-team event ... Thiel had one individual champion, four second place finishers and a pair of fourth place finishers ... Murphy, the second seed at the event, went 3-0 at 165 and won the individual title with a 5-3 victory over top-seeded **Shahiem Bradshaw** of Brockport State ... Bradshaw was ranked eighth in the latest Brute-Adidas NWCA Division III individual rankings ... Senior **Kyle Brown** finished second at 285, losing to top seed and fourth-ranked **Brian Kmetz** of Baldwin-Wallace 7-4 in the championship ... Brown, who was the third seed, went 3-1 on the day ... Sophomore **Andrew Riddle** finished 3-1 at 184, falling to top seed and sixth-ranked **Brett Giehl** of Brockport State in the finals ... Riddle entered Saturday's event as the third seed ... Freshman **Josh Testa** wrestled to a second-place finish at 125, falling to Brockport State's **Rob Vacaro** 6-2 in the championship ... Testa went 2-1 Saturday after losing to top seed and fifth-ranked Vacaro ... Freshman **Damien Rose** also finished second, falling to top-seeded **Luke Baum** of RIT 2-1 in the finals at 141 ... Rose finished the day 3-1 ... Freshmen **Jeff Langdon** and **Jake Rohrer** each posted fourth-place finishes ... Langdon suffered an 11-2 loss to second-seeded **Brian Bucher** of Baldwin-Wallace in the third-place match at 133, while Rohrer fell to second-seeded **Nate Bachman** of RIT 8-3 in the third-place match at 157.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



The Presidents were led by junior **Zak Jenniches**, who posted an 11-2 major decision at 197 pounds over senior **Logan Malie** in the loss to the Tomcats ... W&J freshman 149-pounder **Shaun Yackey** notched his team-leading 16th victory of the season after taking down **Anthony Prvonzac** by a score of 11-5 ... Sophomore **Patrick Wilson** racked up the only other W&J victory, defeating junior **Bo Morrell** by an 8-1 margin ... On Saturday at B-W, Jenniches and freshman heavyweight **Josh Brewer** both recorded fourth-place finishes ... Wilson, Yackey and junior **Pete Elers** all notched fifth-place showings for the Presidents, who placed sixth out of 10 teams.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Waynesburg suffered a tough 45-9 loss on Thursday to Thiel before finishing in ninth place at the 21st annual John Summa Invitational, hosted by Baldwin-Wallace on Saturday ... Against the Matcats, freshman **Nikkien Fautleroy** continued to impress registering a 15-8 decision in the 133-lbs. match ... At 157-lbs., freshman **Mike Catalanto** registered his first collegiate victory, a pin fall at the 2:01 mark ... At the B-W Invitational, Fautleroy claimed first place in the 133-lbs. bracket, posting four victories ... Fautleroy, the third seed in the bracket, opened the tournament with a pin fall at the 4:43 mark before posting an 11-4 decision in the quarterfinals ... Against the second seed, he registered a 15-6 major decision to advance to the championship ... Fautleroy won the championship match via a 5-2 decision over the top seed, a former 125 lb. All-American with 74 career wins ... Freshman **Brandon Miller** also enjoyed success at the annual tournament ... Miller, the 10th seed in the 197-lb. bracket, recorded a pin fall victory in the opening round (1:22) ... After moving to the consolation bracket, Miller posted another win ... In the heavy-weight division, freshman **Melvin Warrick** posted a pair of victories after losing to the eventual champion in his opening bout ... Warrick, the 16th seed in the tournament, won his first bout in the consolation bracket before upsetting the eighth seed with a fall at the 2:22 mark.
