PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

BRANDON COUNCIL

Thiel College

Sophomore - 174 pounds

Council was the top PAC finisher this weekend at the John Summa Invitational, hosted by Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio. He posted a 2-1 record to finish second at 174 pounds, improving to 15-9 on the season. Earlier in the week, he recorded a 15-6 major decision over Tylen Allen of Waynesburg as the Tomcats rolled to a 45-6 PAC dual victory over the Yellow Jackets in Greenville.

Also nominated was freshman 184-pounder **Chris Price** of Washington & Jefferson and senior 149-pounder **Ken Laird** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats



The Tomcats, behind a second-place finish by sophomore **Brandon Council** at 174 pounds and third-place finishes by freshman **Ashton Osterburg** at 125 pounds, senior **Mike Schiemer** at 141 pounds, sophomore **Bo Morrell** at 165 pounds, freshman **Andrew Riddle** at 184 pounds and junior **Kyle Brown** at 285 pounds, finished second at Saturday's 20th Annual John Summa Invitational Tournament, hosted by Baldwin-Wallace ... Nine schools participated in the event ... Brockport State won the event with a final team score of 138.5, followed by Thiel in second place with 100.5 points and Wilmington College in third with 81.4 points ... Tri-State University was fourth (79.5), Rochester Institute of Technology fifth (68.5), Baldwin-Wallace sixth (66.5), Mount Union College seventh (50.5), Washington & Jefferson College eighth (43.0) and Waynesburg College ninth (21.5) ... Council fell by a 5-4 decision to Baldwin-Wallace's **Sterling Sebak** in the championship match at 174 ... Osterburg defeated Tri-State's **Levi Mundy** 9-7 in the third-place match at 125, while Schiemer pinned Tri-State's **Ryan Lineberry** (2:30) in the third-place match at 141 ... Morrell picked up a 9-4 decision over Baldwin-Wallace's **Antonio Campea** at 165 while Riddle earned a 12-6 decision over W&J's **Chris Price** at 184 ... Brown wrestled to a 9-0 major decision against RIT's **Micah Vore** at 285 ... Freshman **Ben Mellring** fell by an 8-6 decision to RIT's **Lee Comstock** in the fifth-place match at 133 and sophomore **James Kara** suffered a 14-3 major decision loss to Mount Union's **Adam Lange**.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



The Washington & Jefferson College wrestling team finished eighth out of nine teams at the 20th Annual John Summa Invitational Tournament Saturday afternoon at the Lou Higgins Center ... Brockport State (N.Y.) claimed the team championship with 138.5 points ... Freshman **Chris Price** recorded W&J's top individual finish after taking fourth place at 184 pounds ... Price dropped a 12-6 decision to Thiel's **Andrew Riddle** in the third-place match ... Sophomore 149-pounder **Pete Elers** and freshman 174-pounder **Patrick Wilson** both earned fifth place after picking up medical forfeits in their fifth-place matches ... Elers was also honored with the "Most Pins" award after notching two falls during the tournament ... Freshman heavyweight **Mitch Tenney** rounded out the Presidents' placewinners with a sixth-place showing. Tenney lost the Tri-State's **Steve Wolf**, 6-4, in the fifth-place match ... Washington & Jefferson hosts the Presidents' Athletic Conference Championships on Thursday evening at the Henry Memorial Center.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



A pair of Yellow Jacket wrestlers - **Tyler Allen** and **Ken Laird** - placed on Saturday at the 20th annual John Summa Invitational hosted by Baldwin-Wallace College ... Laird finished with a 3-2 record in the 149-lbs. bracket after entering match play as the sixth seed ... After a first-round bye, Laird posted a 6-5 decision before falling to third-seed **Sean Connelley** of Mount Union ... Once in the bottom bracket, the Bentworth graduate pinned **Mohammed Salem** of host B-W before winning by medical forfeit to advance to the third-place bout ... In the match, Laird again suffered a defeat to Connelly, 7-4 ... Laird now has recorded 104 career wins, four shy of the career school record set by **Mark Jenkins** (1987-90) ... Allen earned a third-seed in the 174-lbs. bracket before placing sixth in the bracket ... He posted a 2-1 victory over Tri-State's **Louis Posa** before losing to the second and fourth-seed in the bracket ... Freshman **Jacob Benczo** claimed a victory in the 157-lbs. bracket.
