PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

MATT SMITH

Washington & Jefferson College

Senior - 174/184 pounds Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Smith was named PAC Wrestler of the Week for the second consecutive week and the fourth time overall this season after capturing the 174 pound title at the 19th Annual Baldwin-Wallace John Summa Tournament in Berea, Ohio Saturday. He went 3-0, including a 10-4 win over **Todd Miller** of Olivet in the championship bout, to improve to 22-3 on the season.

Also nominated was junior 285-pounder **Kyle Brown** of Thiel and junior 149-pounder **Ken Laird** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel evened its dual meet record (7-7) on Wednesday with its 49-0 rout of Waynesburg ... The Tomcats finished its Presidents' Athletic Conference opener with two pin falls, four forfeits, a major decision at 184-lbs. and a decision at 165lbs. ... Junior Aaron Gibbs posted a pin fall win (1:07) over Nick Dlugonski at 165-lbs., and junior Kyle Brown improved his season record to 24-5 with his win by fall (2:28) over Daniel Goulart at 285 lbs. ... Led by Brown's third place finish at 285lbs., Thiel finished fifth (57.5 pts.) at Saturday's 19th Annual John Summa Invitational Tournament, held at the Baldwin-Wallace Recreation Center in Berea. Ohio ... Thiel had one third place, one fourth place, three fifth place and one six place finisher at the event ... Brown earned a first round bye and defeated Mike Walker of Waynesburg College 8-2 before suffering a fall (2:45) to Brockport State's Pat Bennett ... Brown earned a 5-3 win over Wilmington College's Jeremy Clingner before downing Brockport's Duncan lannucci 2-1 in the third-place match ... Sophomore Corey Murphy finished fourth at 165 pounds with his 2-2 record, losing to Baldwin-Wallace's Joe Heiland 4-2 in the third place match.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson senior Matt Smith claimed the 174-pound championship at the 19th Annual Baldwin-Wallace John Summa Tournament on Saturday in Berea, Ohio ... The Presidents finished in sixth place out of seven teams with 45 points ... Brockport State claimed the team title with 127 points, edging out Olivet (114) ... In addition, freshman 141-pounder Pete Elers placed second, while freshman 125-pounder Jacob Habel finished third ... Smith, the bracket's top seed, earned a 6-1 victory over Baldwin-Wallace's Patrick Rawlinson in the first round and then moved to the finals after defeating Brockport State's Anthony Rivera, 11-6, in the semis ... Smith, who is now 22-3 on the season, won the title and earned his 107th career victory after posting a 10-4 victory against Olivet's Todd Miller in the championship bout ... Elers edged Thiel's Anthony Pavonozac, 3-1, in the opening round before blanking Baldwin-Wallace's Scott Haber by a 4-0 margin in the semifinals ... Top-seeded Dan Roberts of Brockport State pinned Elers in the finals in a time of 4:39 ... After dropping his opening round match, Habel racked up a 5-2 victory against secondseeded Brett Thomas of Baldwin-Wallace in the consolation bracket ... He then shut out Thiel's Brandon Dixon, 5-0, and earned third place after defeating Olivet's Jerry Samson, 5-3 ... W&J will honor Smith on Senior Night on Wednesday's prior to the Mount Union match.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets were shutout by Thiel Thursday, 49-0, prior to the John Summa Invitational at Baldwin- Wallace, where Waynesburg finished seventh ... Thiel staked a 6-0 lead with a forfeit at 125lbs., before Justin Croney defeated James Weishaar with an 8-6 decision at 133-lbs ... Following another Tomcat forfeit, Ken Laird suffered a 9-5 defeat from Mike Kemble at 149-lbs ... Thiel finished its PAC opener with two pinfalls, two forfeits, a major decision at 184 lbs. and a decision at 165 lbs ... Laird and Weishaar, both junior co-captains, placed for Waynesburg at the John Summa Invitational ... Brockport State (N.Y.) won the invite with 127 points, followed by Olivet (Mich.) College (114.3) and host B-W (109) ... Also attending the invitational were PAC schools Thiel (57.5) and Washington & Jefferson (45), who finished in fifth and sixth-place, respectively ... The Yellow Jackets finished seventh (25.5) at the invitational ... Laird posted a 3-1 record in the 149-lbs. bracket to finish third ... After a first-round bye and a loss, he recorded three consecutive victories, including a 4-2 decision in the third-place bout ... At 133-lbs., Weishaar placed fourth with a 2-2 record ... He won his opening match with a 9-7 decision before losing his next match ... Weishaar then recorded a major decision, 11-3, to advance to the third-place bout where he lost to his opponent from Wilmington College.
