W&J freshman 149-pounder Josh Etzel pinned Matt Butler in 4:10 to improve to 5-0 on the season with a pair of falls.

After not joining the team until after football season, Brandon Fedorka not only won the starting heavyweight job, but has quickly gained national recognition for his work on the mats. He went 4-0 this week with two wins by major decision. He clinched Waynesburg's 22-16 win over Division II West Liberty State with an 8-0 major decision, and followed that performance up by going 3-0 at the John Summa Memorial Tournament. He picked up a 12-2 major decision in the semifinals to make it to the title bout where he beat top-seeded John Wilkinson of SUNY-Brockport by 2-1 decision. Fedorka is now 16-4 on the season, has won 13 of his last 14 bouts and was mentioned under the "honorable mention" heading in the d3wrestle.com rankings.

Also nominated was junior 165 pounder **Matt Lowry** of Thiel and freshman 149 pounder **Josh Etzel** of Washington & Jefferson.
