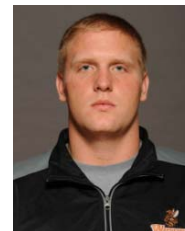

### PAC Wrestler of the Week

After not joining the team until after football season, Brandon Fedorka not only won the starting heavyweight job, but has quickly gained national recognition for his work on the mats. He went 4-0 this week with two wins by major decision. He clinched Waynesburg's 22-16 win over Division II West Liberty State with an 8-0 major decision, and followed that performance up by going 3-0 at the John Summa Memorial Tournament. He picked up a 12-2 major decision in the semifinals to make it to the title bout where he beat top-seeded John Wilkinson of SUNY-Brockport by 2-1 decision. Fedorka is now 16-4 on the season, has won 13 of his last 14 bouts and was mentioned under the "honorable mention" heading in the [d3wrestle.com](http://d3wrestle.com) rankings.

Also nominated was junior 165 pounder **Matt Lowry** of Thiel and freshman 149 pounder **Josh Etzel** of Washington & Jefferson.

The Tomcats evened their PAC record with a 30-13 win at Washington & Jefferson on Friday ... **Corey Brown** registered a pin while **Alec Miller, Matt Lowry, Ryan Murphy** and **Will Ringer** all came through with decisions ... Brown, who is ranked ninth in the nation at 133 pounds, bumped up to 141 and won for the 21st time in 22 matches ... Lowry took down a talented freshman for the second consecutive week with a 6-0 win over David Dibenedetto... Miller notched his 19th win of the season with a 2-1 win at 157.

The Waynesburg wrestling team ended the season in the best way possible ... They finished the dual portion of their schedule with a 22-16 win over traditional Division II power West Liberty State, and followed that up by winning the John Summa Memorial Tournament, which is hosted by Baldwin-Wallace College ... The Yellow Jackets raced out to an 18-0 lead over the first four weights, before the Hilltoppers, who have been ranked as high as 12<sup>th</sup> this year, cut the lead to 18-16 heading into the heavyweight bout ... **Brandon Fedorka** sealed up the 22-16 win with an 8-0 major decision win over Drake Kowcheck ... Fedorka was also one of three individual champions at the Summa Tournament ... Joining him were **Luke Lohr** (149) and **Alex Crown** (125) ... **Jared Roberts**, 174-pounder, made it to the finals, but defaulted out of the title bout after suffering a minor injury ... Waynesburg is now preparing to host this year's PAC Championships on Friday.
