PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

ROB REGNER

Thiel College

Junior - 125 pounds Darlington, Pa./Blackhawk H.S.

Regner was Thiel's top finisher at the John Summa Invitational at Baldwin-Wallace over the weekend, placing second at 125 pounds. He posted a 2-1 mark at the meet, recording a 7-5 decision over **Mike Olem** of Waynesburg and a technical fall (4:37) over B-W's **Mike Ham** before falling to **Jared Selover** of Baldwin-Wallace 7-1 in the championship match.

Also nominated was sophomore 174-pounder **Matt Smith** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman 125-pounder **Mike Olem** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

After suffering a 50-0 dual meet loss at Division II Gannon University on Wednesday, the Thiel wrestling squad finished fifth at the 17th Annual John Summa Invitational Tournament, hosted by Baldwin-Wallace College, on Saturday ... The Golden Knights, ranked 17th in the latest Division II national poll, won three of the middle-weight matches by forfeit (157, 165, 174) ... At the Summa Invitational, junior 125-pounder Rob Regner finished in second place while senior 157-pounder Jack Rice and freshman 149-pounder Jonas Hatajik both finished in third place in their respective weight classes ... Regner picked up a 7-5 decision over Waynesburg's Mike Olem in his openinground match and a tech. fall (4:37) against B-W's Mike Ham before falling to B-W's Jared Selover 7-1 in the championship match ... Rice earned a 16-6 major decision over B-W's Phillip Peak in his first match, but dropped a 5-3 decision to Brockport's Andy Bolce in the following match ... He powered through the consolation bracket, getting a pin (0:25) against Olivet's Jesse Grillio before wrestling to a 15-3 major decision against Olivet's Ken Andrews in the third-place match ... Hatajik won two matches in the consolation bracket before earning a 6-4 over Brockport's Greg McCov in the thirdplace match ... Senior 133-pounder Mark Farrell wrestled to a fourth-place finish while junior 197-pounder T.J. Albright and freshman 125-pounder Shawn Julock both finished sixth in the respective weight classes.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson improved to 2-0 vs. PAC opponents following a 37-6 rout of Waynesburg on Wednesday evening at the Rudy Marisa Field House ... The Presidents won six of the eight matches contested and received two forfeits ... Senior 133-pounder Kevin **DeJuliis** was the first President winner after pinning James Weishaar in 4:54 ... Junior Byron Johnson edged Chris Vicente, 3-2, at 141 pounds to give W&J a 9-3 lead and freshman 149-pounder Matt Miller gave the Presidents a 12-3 advantage after defeating Kenneth Laird, 9-2 ... Junior Chris Day earned a 9-1 major decision over John Maybury at 165 pounds and sophomore 174pounder Matt Smith gave the Presidents a 25-3 lead with a 12-6 victory over Bryan Patnesky ... Smith notched the Presidents' top finish in the 17th Annual John Summa Invitational Tournament hosted by Baldwin-Wallace Saturday after placing second after dropping an 11-5 decision to Brockport State's **Don Favro**, the No. 3 ranked wrestler in Division III, in the championship bout ... DeJulius and Johnson both garnered third-place finishes in their respective weight classes ... DeJulius defeated Thiel's Mark Farrell, 6-1, in the third-place match, while Johnson won the 141-pound consolation bracket following a 7-5 victory over Waynesburg's Vicente.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost its second PAC match of the season Wednesday when the Jackets dropped a 37-6 decision to Washington & Jefferson ... Mike Olem and Jaime **Pradera** registered the lone Yellow Jacket wins ... Olem won a 6-4 decision over Steve Schlauch for the Jackets' first match of the night at 125 ... Pradera won an 8-3 decision over Nate Jones to close out the action 184, before the Jackets forfeited the 197 and 285 pound bouts ... Olem placed third Saturday as three Yellow Jacket wrestlers placed as Waynesburg finished seventh in the 17th Annual John Summa Invitational Tournament hosted by Baldwin-Wallace Saturday ... Waynesburg registered 33.5 points finishing 143 points behind tournament champions Brockport State (176.5) followed by Olivet (90), Baldwin-Wallace (86), Wilmington (70.5), and PAC teams Thiel (64) and Washington & Jefferson (50.5) ... Olem captured third place in the 125-pound tournament, as he pinned Baldwin-Wallace's Mike Ham at the 5:21 mark ... Chris Vicente took home fourth at 141 ... He lost a 7-5 decision to W&J's Byron Johnson in the third-place bout ... Kenneth Laird placed fifth at 149, after winning by injury forfeit in his final match of the consolation bracket.
