Semple ended the regular season red hot as he went 4-0 this past week, with all three victories including bonus points. He earned major decision victories against Division II opponents from Shippensburg and Mercyhurst before pinning his way to the 197pound title at the John Summa Memorial Tournament. The falls came at 4:36 and 4:05 and gave him a teambest 30 wins on the year. Despite not wrestling for three years after high school, Semple has now won 16 bouts in a row and never lost by more than a regular decision.

Also nominated was junior 157pounder **Greg Hogan** of Thiel and freshman 285-pounder **Taylor Potts** of Washington & Jefferson.
