## PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

### MATT SMITH Washington & Jefferson College Junior - 174 pounds

Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Smith earned PAC Wrestler of the Week honors for the second straight week after winning all three of his matches at the Case Western Reserve Quad in Cleveland on Saturday. He posted a pair of decisions before recording a fall in 1:25. Smith moved into third place on the W&J career win list (81) and is two falls away from breaking the school fall record.

Also nominated was sophomore 165-pounder **Aaron Gibbs** of Thiel.

#### Thiel Tomcats

A pinfall victory (4:01) by sophomore Kyle Brown evened the match at 21-21 against D-II Gannon following the 285-pound bout, but due to Criteria F, the tiebreak which states that the team with the fewest number of forfeits wins, Gannon was awarded the dual meet victory ... Gannon came into Wednesday's match ranked 17th nationally in the latest NCAA Division II Wrestling Coaches' Association Top 20 poll ... Sophomores Aaron Gibbs and Nate Santelli finished second in their respective weight classes Saturday as they led Thiel to a fourth-place finish (92.5 pts.) at the Mid-States Conference Tournament, hosted by Olivet College ... Gibbs improved to 19-2 on the season with his 2-1 performance on Saturday at 165 pounds ... He picked up a 17-2 decision over Olivet's Matt Andrews and a fall (3:08) over Chris Henry of MacMurray before falling to Manchester's Jerald Ridley 5-1 in the championship bout ... Santelli pushed his season record to 18-17 with his 3-1 finish at 184 ... Santelli earned a 12-3 decision over Mt. Saint Joseph's Josh Akers before defeating Olivet's Andy Kosinski 13-4 and Manchester's Paul Sorenson 6-1 ... Santelli lost to Joe Seger of Wabash 8-5 in the championship match ... Senior T.J. Albright finished in third place at 197 pounds ... After losing to Olivet's Jeff Wright 5-2 to start the day, Albright rattled off two wins to earn third-place honors ... Sophomore Ted Mangan placed third at 157 pounds, earning a fall (1:30) over Rose-Hulman's Alex Tunis.

## PAC WRESTLING NOTES

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents had a rough weekend in Cleveland as they dropped all three meets ... Junior 174-pounder Matt Smith was the only W&J competitor to win all three of his matches ... Smith notched close wins against Heidelberg (6-4) and RIT (5-2) before picking up a fall in a time of 1:25 versus Case Western Reserve ... Smith moved into third place on the W&J all-time win list with his 81<sup>st</sup> career victory ... Sophomore 197-pounder Ryan Wiles notched a 2-1 mark after notching pinfall victories over Heidelberg (5:47) and R.I.T. (1:30) ... Sophomore heavyweight Ken McDonald also earned a majority decision against R.I.T. by a score of 15-4 ... Senior 141pounder Byron Johnson picked up his lone win of the afternoon versus Case Western Reserve by a 12-4 margin, while senior 157-pounder Chris Day also recorded a 2-1 victory in the loss to Heidelberg.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg was off last week and the team will return to action on Thursday for the PAC Tournament at Thiel ... The Jackets have placed third in the PAC the last two years ... In those two years, Waynesburg has had two wrestlers capture PAC titles: **J.R. Fidler** at 125 lbs. in 2002 and **Jaime Pradera** at 184 lbs. in 2003.
