PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

KEVIN DEJULIUS Washington & Jefferson College Senior - 133 pounds Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

DeJulius became the all-time win leader in Washington & Jefferson wrestling history on Saturday, as he went 3-0 at the Case Western Reserve University Quadrangular to move to 110-32 all-time in his career. He surpassed 2002 W&J graduate Wesley Koteski, who set the record with 108 wins last season. DeJulius topped the mark by topping Mike Huang of CWRU, 5-0, in his second match of the day.

Also nominated was sophomore 141-pounder **Chris Vicente** of Waynesburg.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel, which was idle last week, is looking towards the PAC Wrestling Championships, being held on Thursday, Feb. 20 at the Henry Memorial Center on the campus of Washington & Jefferson College ... The Tomcats have claimed three consecutive conference championships and 10 in the past 12 seasons after finishing with 132 team points at last year's event, while Waynesburg finished second with 94 and W&J third with 68.5 ... The Tomcats claimed six individual conference champions last season, in which only one returns to championships this season ... senior Steve Dedrick earned a 3-2 decision last year over Waynesburg's Chris Vincente at 149 pounds to take the individual championship ... Junior Rob Regner lost 5-4 in the championship match to J.R. Fidler of Waynesburg at 125 pounds, and junior T.J. Albright fell 4-1 to W&J's Wes Koteski at 184 ... Thiel fell to W&J 25-24 on Jan. 16 and defeated Waynesburg at the Case Western Reserve Quad meet 36-18 on Nov. 23 before earning a 26-19 victory over the Yellow Jackets on Jan. 30.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Senior 133-pounder Kevin DeJuliis became W&J's all-time win leader by posting a 3-0 record at the Case Western Reserve Quadrangular on Saturday in Cleveland, Ohio ... The Presidents went 2-1 during the meet as they defeated R.I.T, 26-18, and Case Western Reserve, 30-22, before dropping a 28-15 decision to Heidelberg ... DeJuliis picked up his 109th career victory by defeating Case Western Reserve's Mike Huang, 5-0, in his second match of the day ... DeJulius passes Wesley Koteski '02, who set the all-time record of 108 wins last season ... After his 3-0 day, DeJuliis' career mark now stands at 110-32 ... In the win over R.I.T, DeJuliis picked up the Presidents' first victory by pinning Mike Pietrowski in 4:59 ... He then notched his third win in as many matches by shutting out Dustin McClintock of Heidelberg, 8-0 ... Freshman heavyweight Ryan Wiles also recorded a 3-0 mark for the Presidents ... He earned two pinfall victories, defeating Heidelberg's Chris Lynch in 2:32 and Luke Zajac of R.I.T. in 2:39 ... Wiles also notched a 9-2 decision over CWRU's Nate Logan ... Junior 149-pounder Chris Day and sophomore 174-pounder Matt Smith both won two of three matches ... Day defeated Steve Vaughn of R.I.T, 3-0, and picked up a forfeit win ... Smith pinned Mike Morgan of CWRU in 4:29 and defeated R.I.T.'s Sean Dust, 18-9, before falling to Heidelberg's Alex McElroy, 8-5 ... W&J hosts the PAC Championships on Thursday at the Henry Memorial Center at 6 p.m.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg took fifth place at the Mid-States Wrestling League Tournament at Manchester, Ind., Saturday, as three Jackets placed at either third or fourth in their weight classes ... Manchester (171) won the title for a consecutive year, and its 9th in the last 11 years ... Following the Spartans were Olivet (138.5), Wabash (111.5), Mount St. Joseph's (59), Waynesburg (56.5), Rose-Hulman (31) and MacMurray (11) ... Chris Vicente placed the highest for Waynesburg, as he decisioned Manchester's Mike Hanlin, 7-5, at 141 ... Mike Olem took home fourth in the 125-pound bracket, after bowing out to Manchester's Nick lannarelli by pinfall at 5:51 ... Jaime Pradera lost a major decision, 10-2, to Olivet's Jason Creager in the third-place bout for 184 ... Waynesburg will now enter Thursday's PAC Tournament at Washington & Jefferson.
