Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel College wrestling team wrestled to a seventh-place finish (52.5 points) at Saturday's NCAA Division III Midwest Regional Wrestling Qualifier, held at the Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology Sports and Recreation Center in Terre Haute, Ind. ... The Tomcats claimed one first-, one fourth-, one fifth-, and two sixth-place finishes ... Senior 141-pounder Jeff Linn entered his bracket as the top seed and defeated #2 seed Rocky Burkett of Manchester College 6-4 in the final to earn championship laurels ... With his victory, Linn advances to next weekend's NCAA Division III National Championship at the First Union Center in Philadelphia to compete for a national championship ... Linn was also a NCAA national qualifier in 1999 ... At 125-pounds sophomore Rob Regner finished in fourth place after falling to Waynesburg's J.R. Fiddler 10-0 in the third-place match ... At 133pounds sophomore Chris Brown finished sixth, losing by pin-fall to MacMurray College's Leo Blay at 3:48 ... At 149-pounds junior Steven Dedrick

earned fifth-place after defeating Olivet College's **Chris Dunham** 12-4 in the fifth-place match ... Senior 197-pounder **Jason Miklacic** finished sixth in his class after forfeiting in the fifth-place match to Manchester College's **Jeremiah Rakoczy**.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson wrestling team tied for second place of 12 teams at the NCAA Division III Midwest Regional Qualifier on Saturday at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology in Terre Haute, Ind. ... The Presidents finished the event with a total of 91 points ... Three W&J grapplers qualified for the next weekend's NCAA Division III Championships held at the First Union Center in Wilkes Barre, Pa., hosted by the University of Scranton and King's College ... Junior 133-pounder Kevin DeJulius and freshman 165-pounder Aaron Gibbs both earned trips to the Division III Championships after winning regional championships in their respective weight classes as the No. 1 seed ... DeJulius became the first W&J wrestler to qualify for the national tournament after claiming the 133-pound championship at the regional ... In the championship bout, DeJulius qualified for the national tournament with a pinfall victory over Nathan Hills of Manchester at the 6:39 mark ... Gibbs pinned his first two opponents in a total of 3:41, before defeating Case Western Reserve's Chris Nader by pinfall in the finals at the 7:34 mark ... Senior 184-pounder Wes Koteski qualified for the second consecutive season after finishing as the runner-up in the regional ... Following the tournament, the region's coaches voted Koteski in as a wildcard for the NCAA Championships ... W&J advanced the most wrestlers to the NCAA Tournament in the program's history.

Sophomore J.R. Fidler (125 lb.) and freshman Chris Vicente (149) placed third in the Regional ... Freshman Derek Maple (133) placed fourth in his weight class while two other Jackets, senior Mike O'Neil (157) and junior Matt Queen (165), placed fifth ... Freshmen Bryan Patnesky (174) and Kelby Church (Hwt.) each placed sixth.
