## PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

Garber impressed in his collegiate debut at the Messiah Invitational, winning the championship at 141-lbs. with a 3-0 victory, including two pin falls. The freshman entered the bracket as the third seed and enjoyed an opening-round bye. In his first bout of the day, he defeated Jeff Mazurek of Kings College via pin fall at the 1:10-mark before defeating second-seeded Barry Thrush of the host Falcons with an 11-6 decision. The newcomer registered a pin fall over Tony Miele of Kings College, the top seed in the bracket, at the 1:08-mark in the championship bout.

Also nominated was freshman 125-pounder **Rob Miller** of Thiel, and junior 285-pounder **Josh Brewer** of Washington & Jefferson.

### Thiel Tomcats



The Tomcat wrestling squad opened their 2007-2008 season Sunday at the W&J Open ... Freshman 125-pound **Rob Miller** finished 3-1 with a win by fall over **Scott Puglisi** from Scranton and a technical fall victory against **Scott Morgan** of Pitt-Johnstown (21-6) ... He also earned a 3-1 decision over **Lucas Huffman** of West Liberty, a returning Division II national qualifier ... His only loss of the day was to **John Bittinger** of Duquesne (3-2), a returning Division I national qualifier ... Junior 149-pound **Greg Hogan** went 4-1 on the day...Hogan had victories over **Josh Volker** of Seton Hill (Inj. Def.), a 7-2 decision over **Ryan Romano** of WVU, a 3-1 decision over **Alec Miller** and a win by fall (4:45) over **Ryan Donovan** of Mercyhurst North East.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



Washington & Jefferson opened its 2007-2008 season with a 30-15 loss to Apprentice at the Henry Memorial Center ... The Presidents were led by senior 157-pounder **Pete Elers** and sophomore 174-pounder **Eric Monday**, who both earned victories by falls ... Freshman 184-pounder **Alex Cressley** recorded the Presidents' only other victory ... Sophomore heavyweight **Josh Brewer** collected the Presidents' best finish at the W&J Open Invitational by placing third.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Behind a first-place finish by freshman **Nick Garber** at 141-lbs., Waynesburg finished sixth at the season-opening Messiah College Invitational on Saturday ... In addition to Garber, sophomore heavyweight **Melvin Warrick** and freshman **Jason King** placed at the seven-team invitational ... Garber entered the 141-lbs. bracket as the third seed and enjoyed an opening-round bye. In his first collegiate bout, he won via pin fall at the 1:10-mark before winning his second match with an 11-6 decision ... The newcomer registered a pin fall at the 1:08-mark in the championship bout ... In the heavyweight division, Warrick worked his way to a third-place finish in the wrestleback after losing his opening match. The Connellsville graduate defeated teammate **Rich Janicki** with a pin in the opening minute before claiming a 6-4 victory over senior teammate **LR Neubauer** ... Warrick then won by medical forfeit to advance to the third-place bout ... The sophomore then registered a 6-5 victory to finish the day ... King entered the 174-lbs. unranked and opened his collegiate career with an 8-3 decision before being forced to the wrestleback ... In the wrestleback, King earned a pin fall at 1:35 before claiming a narrow 7-6 decision ... After advancing to the third-place match via medical default, the Uniontown product suffered a 1-0 loss.
