The event featured 12 Division I schools, as well as a number of Division II, Division III and junior college participants ... Over 440 wrestlers participated in the open ... Highlighting the day for Thiel was junior 149-pound **Mike Kemble** ... Kemble went 2-0 with a 23-second pin fall over Alfred State's **Greg Davis** and an 8-1 win over the University of Buffalo's **Pat Lloyd**.

Washington & Jefferson College and first-year head coach **Jay Robison** will begin their 2005-2006 season at the Slippery Rock Invitational on Saturday ... Team and individual results were still not available by Monday morning ... The Presidents will compete in the McDaniel Duals this Saturday at 10:00 am ... Robison took over at W&J this fall after replacing **Angelo Morascyzk** who retired after 13 seasons ... Robison, a three-time NCAA Division I All-American at Edinboro, served the past three seasons as the top assistant at Division I Clarion.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



The Yellow Jackets started the 2005-06 campaign at the eight-team Messiah Invitational this weekend and finished in seventh place ... Senior wrestler **Ken Laird** and junior newcomer **Dave Thorn** both placed in their respective weight classes ... Laird entered the tournament as the No. 2 seed in the 149-lbs. bracket and received an opening round bye ... After that, the senior posted victories in his next matches, including a 7-0 decision over the third seed from McDaniel, who won the invitational ... However, in the championship bout, Laird lost via a 5-3 decision to the first-seeded wrestler from McDaniel ... At 125-lbs., Thorn posted a 3-1 record and a third-place finish with wins over both the third and fourth-seeded wrestlers in the bracket ... Sophomore **Tyler Allen** earned a fifth-seed in the 174-lbs. bracket and posted an opening round win before following in two subsequent matches, including a 13-11 decision to the fourth-seeded wrestler from Williamson Trade.
