Wrestler of the Week

NICK GARBER Waynesburg Sophomore Waynesburg, Pa. Waynesburg Central H.S.



Garber cruised to the 133pound title at the Messiah Invitational on Saturday, going 3-0 with three pin-fall victories. In the championship match, he defeated second seed Michael Testa of Johns Hopkins in just 17 seconds to give him the 133pound title at Messiah for the second consecutive year.

Also nominated was sophomore 125-pounder **Rob Miller** of Thiel, and freshman 149pounder **Dominick Demor** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC Wrestling 2008-09 - Week 1 Conference Notes

SEASON UNDERWAY: The 2008-09 PAC wrestling campaign is underway, as Washington & Jefferson and Waynesburg will again look to unseat conference top dog Thiel for the league championship ... The Tomcats have captured nine consecutive conference titles and have taken the trophy in 16 of the past 18 seasons ... In 2007, Thiel posted 145.5 points at the PAC Championship, followed by W&J (105.5) and Waynesburg (58).

WHO'S HOT: Washington & Jefferson freshman 149-pounder **Dominick Demor** notched a 5-1 record during his opening collegiate weekend ... Demor placed third at 149 pounds in the W&J Open on Saturday, after recording a 12-4 major decision of **Swan Sexton** of West Virginia Tech on Friday night ... Thiel went 1-2 at the Baldwin-Wallace Quadrangular on Saturday, led by 125-pounder **Rob Miller** who was 3-0 with two pins and a major decision. AROUND THE LEAGUE: John Sabatelli (165), Brandon Roshon (157) and sophomore Alex Cressley (197) joined Demor in posting major decision for W&J in a 28-13 dual win over West Virginia Tech on Friday ... Waynesburg opened the season under the direction of new head coach Ron Headlee by placing fourth at the Messiah Invitational ... The Yellow Jackets finished the eight-team invitational event with 62 points, led by Nick Garber's 133-pound title (see above).
