PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

KYLE BROWN

Thiel College

Junior - 285 pounds Meadville, Pa./Meadville H.S.

Brown was a perfect 4-0 for the Tomcats on Saturday at the Green Terror Duals, hosted by McDaniel College, as he led Thiel to a 3-1 dual match record and third place finish. He recorded a pair of pin fall victories and a pair of decisions.

Also nominated was senior 184-pounder **Matt Smith** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman 165-pounder **Tyler Allen** of Waynesburg.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel got off on the right foot Saturday as they opened the 2004-05 season finishing third with a 3-1 record at the fourth annual Sam Case Green Terror Duals, hosted by McDaniel College ... The Tomcats routed Gallaudet University 59-0 in round one, claiming seven of the ten victories by pin fall ... In round two the Tomcats were able to outscore Johns Hopkins University 21-19 for the win before losing to the United States Naval Academy's Blue Team 3-42 in the fourth round ... Thiel rebounded with a 24-24 criteria win over host McDaniel to earn the third-place finish ... Junior 285-pounder Kyle Brown posted a perfect 4-0 mark at the duals ... He recorded a pair of pin fall victories over Gallaudet's Leto and McDaniel's Aaron Jenowski (1:27) and decisions over Johns Hopkins' deGaravilla (10-3) and Navy's Cottrell (12-6) ... Junior 157pounder Ted Mangan went 2-0 on the day, picking up a 4-3 decision over Johns Hopkins' Reitmayr and a pin fall victory (4:35) over McDaniel's Greg Hammock.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J wrestling opened its 2004-2005 season with a fifth-place finish out of 11 teams at the Messiah Invitational ... Senior 184-pounder Matt Smith and junior 197-pounder Ryan Wiles both garnered second-place finishes ... Smith opened with an 11-1 decision over Matt Heisler of Thaddeus Stevens and then edged second-seeded Tim Pentz of Messiah, 5-4, to move into the championship ... Top-seeded Mike Troutman of Ursinus defeated Smith, 11-4 ... Wiles racked up falls over Ursinus' James Domestico (2:51) and Johns Hopkins' Tony Dambro (1:12) to move into the championship where he was pinned by No. 1 Jason O'Reilly of King's (Pa.) ... Sophomore 133-pounder Mark Day and freshman 125-pounder Jacob Habel also posted third-place showings ... Smith, Wiles and sophomore heavyweight Phil McCormick each won all three of their matches this past weekend ... Smith pinned McDaniel's Steve Jennings in 5:44 and then notched a major decision against Messiah's Tim Pentz (13-5) and pinned UMBC's Tim Lombardo ... Wiles opened with a fall against McDaniel's Leon Checca in 1:30 ... He then posted another pinfall victory as he took down Messiah's Mike Orfanos in 4:28 and concluded his day with a fall against Sam Lanciotti of UMBC ... McCormick racked up three close wins starting with a 3-0 triumph of McDaniel's Aaron Janowski ... He edged Messiah's Ethan Bucarey, 3-2, and then beat UMBC's Tim Parshley, 3-1.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College wrestling team posted 1-2 on Saturday in its first dual action of the season at the Case Western Reserve quad meet .. Waynesburg defeated the host Spartans, 29-15, before falling to Baldwin-Wallace, 12-44, and Mt. St. Joseph, 9-36 ... Freshmen Matthew Smith, a 165-pounder, won all three of his matches during the day, including a pin at the 3:40 mark against Brian Haines of B-W in the second match ... Smith, along with classmate Tyler Allen and junior Chris Van Dine each recorded multiple victories for the Yellow Jackets at the quad meet ... At 125-pounds, Smith posted a 2-1 record at the meet, as he won his first match by a technical fall over Tom Chambers of Case Western, 16-0, before pinning junior Michael Ham of B-W at the 6:07 mark ... Van Dine won his match with a 5-4 decision at 174-pounds against Mt. St. Joseph after winning by forfeit against host Case Western ... Junior 149-pounder Ken Laird was the only other Yellow Jacket wrestler to record a win via a nonforfeit when he posted a 10-4 decision over Nathan Klingensmith of Case Western.
