Thiel finished with six top-five finishers at the Ursinus Fall Brawl on Sunday ... Sophomore **Damian Rose** claimed the individual title at 141 pounds and went

4-0 on the day, posting an 11-6 decision over sixth-ranked Billy Hall of Muhlenberg College in the championship semifinals ... He recorded a 5-3 decision against John Barnett of the College of New Jersey in the championship final ... Junior 184-pound Andrew Riddle finished second and went 2-1 on the day ... He lost to Muhlenberg's Matt Horn 12-5 in the championship finals ... Sophomore 133-pound Jeff Langdon chose perhaps the longest road to a thirdplace finish, dropping an 8-3 decision to Steve Kingwood of Ursinus in his opening match before recording five straight wins that culminated with his 12-7 decision over Andrew Lewis in the consolation finals ... Freshman Robbie Miller wrestled to a thirdplace finish, losing to Kyle Kinchin of the College of New Jersey 9-6 in double overtime in the championship semifinals ... Sophomore 285-pound Mike Edwards finished fourth, losing to seventh-ranked Steve Carbone of the College of New Jersey 3-1 in the consolation semifinals ... In his opening match, Edwards recorded an 8-1 decision against Joe Tartar of Muhlenberg, a 2007 Division III national qualifier ... Junior 165-pound Bryan Pleskovich also earned a fourth-place finish with a 3-2 record ... Earlier in the week, Thiel opened its home and dual schedule with a 29-12 decision against NCAA Division II Seton Hill.

... Monday competed in the 174-pound bracket and posted a 4-2 record to claim fourth place ... He defeated Bridgewater State's **Phil Mastro** by fall (5:22) in the opening round and then earned three victories in the consolation bracket before losing by forfeit in the fifth-place match ... Freshman 125-pounder **Brandon Samson** also earned a first-round victory by fall in 57 seconds over Rhode Island's **Ryan Hardy**, while senior 184-pounder **Chris Price** and sophomore heavyweight **Josh Brewer** both collected two wins in the winner's bracket before falling in the consolations.
