Gibbs opened the 2001-02 season with a perfect 5-0 record with three pinfalls. He captured first place honors in the 165-pound weight class at the King's Invitational in Allentown, Pa., last weekend, going 4-0 in his first collegiate action. His pinfall in the first period against Muskingum on Saturday put W&J ahead for good.

Also nominated was senior **Jack Rice** (165 lbs.) of Thiel and sophomore **Brian Wolfe** (Hwt.) of Waynesburg.
