### Thiel Tomcats



Thiel finished in third place at the 17-team Doug Parker Invitational Saturday ... The Tomcats finished with seven total place winners and 118.5 team points ...

Seniors **Corey Murphy** and **Kyle Brown**, along with freshman **Josh Testa**, each placed third in their respective weight classes ... Murphy and Brown went 5-1 at 165 and 285 pounds, respectively, while Testa compiled a record of 5-1 at 125 ... Sophomores **Ashton Osterberg** and **Mitch Costa**, along with freshmen **Rhett Northcraft** and **Cody Potts**, each earned a fifth-place finish in their respective weight classes ... Osterberg went 6-2 at 125 pounds while Northcraft finished 6-2 at 157 pounds ... Costa was 4-2 at 174 pounds while Potts finished 4-2 at 197 pounds.
