Murphy was a perfect 5-0 for the Tomcats last week at 165 pounds, as he posted a win in a dual against D-II West Liberty State before going 4-0 to capture the title at his weight class at the Doug Parker Invitational, hosted by McDaniel College in Westminster, Md.

Also nominated was senior 149-pounder **Ken Laird** of Waynesburg.

### **Thiel Tomcats**



After opening the week with a 30-6 dual-match loss at Div. II West Liberty, the Tomcats bounced back with a fourth-place finish at the 17-team Doug Parker Invitational, hosted by

Springfield College ... Junior 165-pound Corey Murphy and junior 285-pound Kyle Brown wrestled their way to individual titles Saturday ... Murphy, fifth in the latest individual rankings, picked up a 19-4 win over Western New England College's Eric Nelson in his opening match and followed that up with an 8-2 decision over Bridgewater State College's John Fralick ... He posted a 19-6 major decision in the semifinals before earning a 10-6 decision over Norwich College's Shaun Vacher in the championship match at 165 pounds ... Brown began his day with a 7-0 decision over Curtis Ezell of SUNY-Oswego and a pin fall win (2:57) over Daniel Fuentes of MIT ... Brown picked up a 7-4 decision over John Oko of Western New England in the semifinals and defeated Tim Ferreira of Bridgewater 3-1 in the championship match at 285 pounds ... Sophomore 125-pound James Moffatt was a secondplace finisher after posting a 3-1 mark ... Moffatt fell by pin fall (1:43) to Anthony Nicolichia of Roger Williams University in the championship match ... Junior 149pound Mike Kemble finished the day 3-1 and earned a third-place finish, defeating Pat Barnes of Western New England 20-3.

Sophomore 133-pounder **Jacob Habel**, who was named the Presidents' Athletic Conference Wrestler of the Week last week, recorded a 3-0 triumph in the opening match for W&J ... The Presidents only other victory came at 165 pounds when junior **Kurt Lorenz** an 11-6 win ... W&J will not wrestle again until December 3rd when it competes in the York (Pa.) Tournament.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



The Yellow Jacket wrestling team competed in the Fall Brawl Tournament hosted by Ursinus College on Saturday ... Senior Ken Laird recorded three wins for a third-place finish, while sophomore Tyler Allen also

posted three victories ... Full team standings are not available at this time ... Laird posted a 3-1 record in the 149 lb. bracket ... After receiving an opening round bye, the senior registered a 13-2 major decision in his first bout before a 9-7 victory via decision ... However, Laird lost his next match via a 5-2 decision to the eventual champion in the bracket ... In the third-place bout, he rebounded with a pinfall at the 3:27-mark ... At 174 lbs., Allen won his opening match with a 10-2 major decision before losing in the second-round ... He then rebounded with two victories via pinfalls in the consolation bracket ... Due to time restraints, the entire bracket was not completed which prevented Allen from placing ... Also registering a win for Waynesburg at the Fall Brawl were Dave Thorn at 125 lbs., Jason Weeks at 165 lbs. and L.R. Neubauer, who victory came on a pinfall less than a minute into the match.
