## **PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK**

### **KYLE BROWN**

**Thiel College**

Junior - 285 pounds

Meadville, Pa./Meadville H.S.

Brown earned PAC Wrestler of the Week laurels for the second straight week after going 5-1 at the Doug Parker Invitational at Springfield College. He led Thiel to a third-place finish in the 21-team field while posting the second-most fall (four) and fifth-most points (20.5) of any wrestler at the event.

Also nominated was junior 197-pounder **Ryan Wiles** of Washington & Jefferson.

## PAC WRESTLING NOTES

### **Thiel Tomcats**

Behind the third-place finishes of senior heavyweight **Kyle Brown** and sophomore 165 pound **Corey Murphy**, the Tomcats battled to a third-place finish (108 pts.) at Saturday's 15th annual Doug Parker Invitational, hosted by Springfield College ... Thiel totaled a pair of third-place finishes, three fourth-place finishes and a fifth-place finish ... Brown went 5-1 on the day, earning the second-most falls (four) and the fifth-most points scored (20.5) at the invite ... He defeated Southern Maine's **Matt Waite** 5-1 in the consolation finals ... Murphy was 5-1 at the invitational and picked up a 4-3 victory over RIC's **Arty Privedenyuk** in the consolation finals ... sophomore 184-pounder **Nate Santelli** wrestled to a fourth place finish, going 5-2 on the day ... Santelli fell to Messiah's **Tim Pentz** 4-2 in the consolation finals ... Freshman 149 pound **Anthony McCorvey** finished fourth with a 6-2 record, battling back from a 16-13 first-round loss to STCC's **Pat Barnes** ... McCorvey strung six-straight wins together before falling in the consolation finals 2-0 to Wesleyan's **Kevin Egolf** ... Freshman 157-pounder **Brandon Council** finished with a 5-2 record and took fourth in his respective weight class, losing in the championship semifinals to Wesleyan's **Adam Jonas** 6-2 ... After an injury default win in the consolation semifinals Council fell to Wesleyan's **Dan DeLalla** 7-4.

### **Wash. & Jeff. Presidents**

Junior 197-pounder **Ryan Wiles** won his fourth consecutive match by fall, but Muskingum still pulled out a 28-18 victory over Washington & Jefferson in non-conference wrestling action on Wednesday evening in Ohio ... Wiles, who won the first six matches by fall this season, pinned **Matt Viers** in a time of 5:34 ... Sophomore 133-pounder **Mark Day** was the only other President to win his match as he pinned **Robert Bernhardt** in 3:23 ... Freshman **Jacob Habel** was also awarded a forfeit at 125 pounds ... Day led the Presidents at Ursinus on Saturday with three wins in five matches ... Freshman 141-pounder **Pete Elers**, Habel and Wiles also all notched a pair of wins.
