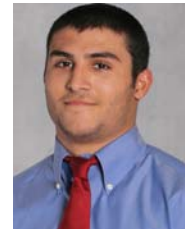

Dibenedetto posted a 4-2 record during the week and upset the defending national champion at 165 pounds. He faced Vincent Renaut of King's Point in the opening round and pulled out a 2-1 victory. Renaut, a senior, was named the 2010 NCAA Division III Championships Most Outstanding Wrestler after winning last year's national title at 165 pounds. Dibenedetto added victories over Norwich's Mike Babbia (7-3) and Stevens Institute's James Holdin (8-7) before dropping his final two matches.

Also nominated was junior 133-pounder **Corey Brown** of Thiel and freshman 125-pounder **Alex Crown** of Waynesburg.

**(2-2, 0-0 PAC)**



Thiel finished 2-2 at the Mount Union Duals with wins over Mount St. Joseph and King's College and losses to 19<sup>th</sup>-ranked Ohio Northern and 29<sup>th</sup>-ranked Mount Union... Junior **Corey Brown** went 4-0 on the day, including a pin, a technical fall and a 6-3 decision over returning national qualifier Riki Reynolds of Mount Union ... **Alec Miller** and **Patrick Morris** each recorded 3-1 records ... Two-time PAC champion **Matt Lowry** made his season debut after missing the first two competitions of the year with an injury ... He rolled to a technical fall in his first match and was on pace to do the same in his second match before his opponent bowed out with an injury ... **Michael Klosiewicz** finished 2-2... Freshman **Matt Mullett** posted his first career win with a technical fall and also wrestled tough in a 5-0 loss Mount Union's Bill Schindel, who is ranked fourth nationally... The match was scoreless in the third period before Schindel pulled away with a takedown and two nearfall pts... Thiel will compete at the Ohio Northern Invitel on Saturday.

W&J completed a successful week with a dual-meet win at Scranton and a host of solid performances in Massachusetts ... Highlighting the weekend was 165-pounder **David Dibenedetto**, who upset the defending national champion in the opening round at Springfield ... Dibenedetto faced Vincent Renaut of King's Point in the opening round and pulled out a 2-1 victory ... Renaut was named the 2010 NCAA Division III Championships Most Outstanding Wrestler after winning last year's national title at 165 pounds ... Dibenedetto added victories over Norwich's Mike Babbia (7-3) and Stevens Institute's James Holdin (8-7) before dropping his final two matches ... **Robbie Mies**, 197-pounder, placed fourth ... He opened with falls against MIT's Brian Anderson (2:56) and Centenary's JJ Mitchell (1:46) before losing in the semifinals to eventual champion Tom Voorhis of SUNY-Brockport (11-7) ... Mies bounced back to defeated Jeremy Burns of Springfield by a 7-2 margin, but Mitchell earned a 6-2 victory in a rematch from earlier in the afternoon during the third-place match ... Five W&J wrestlers won matches at Scranton, including junior **Dominick Demor**, Mies and Dibenedetto, who all recorded technical falls.

The Waynesburg wrestling team went 1-1-1 at a quad-match hosted by York on Saturday ... After suffering their first dual match loss of the year to 27<sup>th</sup>-ranked Messiah, the Yellow Jackets bounced back with a 21-18 triumph over Division II Lake Erie ... The Jackets ended the day by tying the host Spartans 18-18 ... Sophomore 125-pounder **Alex Crown** and freshman 149-pounder **Luke Lohr** led the charge by both going 3-0 for the day ... Crown picked up a win by technical fall, while Lohr downed an opponent with a major decision ... According to the National Wrestling Coaches' Association (NWCA), Lohr is tied for second place in all weights of Division III in wins (11-2).
