PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

MIKE OLEM

Waynesburg College Sophomore - 125 pounds Herndon, Va./Herndon H.S.

Olem started the season with a perfect 2-0 record, after posting a pair of dual meet wins for the Yellow Jackets last week. He recorded a major decision over Tom Chambers of Case Western Reserve (10-0) before pinning Mike Ham of Baldwin-Wallace at 5:23.

Also nominated was sophomore 157-pounder Ted Mangan of Thiel, and senior 141-pounder Byron Johnson of Washington & Jefferson.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel placed third at last weekend's Doug Parker Invitational, finishing with 74.00 team points ... The Tomcats had five wrestlers finish in the top six, led by sophomore Ted Mangan, who wrested to a third-place finish at 157 pounds ... Mangan went 7-1 in the tournament with four of those wins coming by way of pinfall victories ... Freshman Corey Murphy placed fourth at 149 pounds, falling to Wesleyan's Kevin Egolf 4-2 in the thirdplace match ... Sophomore Matt Kirsopp (141), junior T.J. Albright (197) and freshman Steve Britton (285) also finished in the top six in their respective weight classes ... Britton, who went 4-2 at the tourney, defeated eighthranked Jeremy Calkins of SUNY-Oswego by pinfall (1:17) in his first-round match and then came back to defeat Calkins again 3-2 later in the consolations ... Kirsopp went 4-2 at 141 while Albright finished 3-2 at 197.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened its 2003-2004 season at home on Wednesday evening with a 35-3 loss at Muskingum ... Senior 141-pounder Byron Johnson, who won the Midwest Regional last season and advanced to the NCAA Division III Championships, picked up the lone President win by a score of 8-2 ... Johnson, junior 174-pounder Matt Smith and sophomore heavyweight Ken McDonald all posted second-place finishes at the Red Dragon Invitational in Oneonta, N.Y., on Saturday ... Johnson, the bracket's top seed, fell in the championship bout, 5-2, to secondseeded John Muscarella of Wilkes ... Smith lost to Plymouth State's Nate Kittredge in the finals, while McDonald was topped by Johns Hopkins' Karol Gryczynski.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost two matches in its first dual action of the season on Saturday at Baldwin-Wallace against the host Yellow Jackets (36-18) and Case Western Reserve (33-15) ... Waynesburg wrestled well, winning eight of 12 bouts, but had to forfeit four weight classes in each match ... Sophomore 125pounder Mike Olem major decisioned Case's Tom Chambers, 10-0, before pinning B-W's Mike Ham at 5:23 ... Waynesburg's only other win by fall was J.R. Fidler over B-W's Ed Walters at 1:24. Waynesburg forfeited 157, 165, 175, and 184 ... Olem, Fidler, and Vicente (141) all registered two wins.
