PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

MATT SMITH

Washington & Jefferson College Sophomore - 174 pounds Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Smith earned the first PAC Wrestler of the Week award for 2002-03 by going 4-0 with four pinfalls last week. He pinned his opponent in 6:20 in a dual at Muskingum on Wednesday, then cruised to the 174-pound title at the Red Dragon Invitational at Oneonta State (N.Y.) by winning all three matches by fall. He defeated Athony Cohen of Cortland State with a pin at the 2:48 mark of the championship bout.

Also nominated was senior 149-pounder **Steve Dedrick** of Thiel and senior heavyweight **Chris Pierce** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

After falling to Mt. Union 35-3 at Rissell-Beeghly Gymnasia on Wednesday, the Tomcats went 2-1 at the Case Western Reserve Quad Meet on Saturday ... They were defeated by Baldwin-Wallace 32-15 in the opening match, but went on to defeat Case Western Reserve 33-16 and Waynesburg 36-18 ... Senior 149-pounder Steve Dedrick went 2-1 at the quad with two pinfall wins ... Freshman 157-pounder John Svirbly picked up his first collegiate win against Baldwin-Wallace, an 8-4 decision over Scott Conrath ... Svirbly finished 3-1 at the guad ... First-year head coach George Dunn picked up his first collegiate coaching win against Case Western Reserve ... Freshman 141pounder Matt Kirsopp also earned his first collegiate win with a pinfall victory over Waynesburg's Chris Vicente.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson wrestling team opened its 2002-2003 season with a 24-16 loss at Muskingum on Wednesday evening in Muskingum, Ohio ... Senior Kevin DeJulius, the preseason No. 3 ranked wrestler in Division III, defeated Jose Smith to post a win in his first match of the year ... Sophomore 174pounder Matt Smith also picked up a victory by fall at the 6:20 mark for the Presidents ... Freshman 149-pounder Matt Miller got the Presidents off to a guick start with an 11-4 victory in the night's first match and junior Chris Day was the only other W&J winner following a 10-1 triumph ... Smith claimed the 174-pound championship at the Oneonta State Red Dragon Wrestling Invitational on Saturday evening ... Smith defeated Cortland State's Anthony Cohen at the 2:48 mark by pinfall to claim the title and also picked up pinfall victories in his first two matches of the tournament ... DeJulius and junior 141-pounder Byron Johnson each earned runner-up finishes in their respective weight classes ... DeJulius dropped a 9-6 decision to Cliff Medina of Hunter in the championship bout, while Johnson was decisioned by Plymouth State's Shaun Cleary, 11-6, in his final match.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg went 1-2 over the weekend at the Case-Western Reserve quads for its first dual action of the season ... Waynesburg defeated the host Spartans, 24-23, with wins by Ken Laird and Chris Pierce ... Laird won a 10-7 decision over Mike Morgan, while Pierce topped Josh Schmidt, 14-9, in the heavyweight bout ... The Jackets also won by forfeit at 125, 149, and 174 ... The Jackets suffered losses to Baldwin-Wallace, 45-6, and Thiel, 36-18, in non-conference action ... Jaime Pradera was the lone winner for Waynesburg against Baldwin-Wallace after he pinned James Payne in the 184pound bout ... Bryan Patnesky also won by fall against Thiel at 174, as did Pierce in heavyweight action ... J.R. Fidler and Derek Maple won by decision at 125 and 133, respectively ... Fidler won a 6-5 decision over Josh Horne, while Maple defeated Mark Ferrell, 5-1.
