# **PAC Wrestler of the Week**

WES KOTESKI - Washington & Jefferson College Senior - 184 lbs.

Plum, Pa./Plum H.S.

Koteski claimed the championship at 184 pounds at the Petrofes Tournament this past weekend, going 4-0 with two victories by pinfall. He defeated **Tom Medonis** of Springfield 7-5 in the championship match. In the process, Koteski helped lead Washington & Jefferson to its best-ever finish in 32 years of the Petrofes Tournament.

Also nominated was junior Steven Dedrick of Thiel.

# Thiel Tomcats

Thiel had three individuals wrestle in the finals of last weekend's Petrofes-Messiah Inviational ... Mike Schiemer, seeded second at 133 pounds, was defeated by Nate Yeasted of Muhlenburg 8-5 in the third place match ... Steven Dedrick, seeded sixth at 149 pounds, defeated the seventh-seeded Stuart Jackson of Mount Union 8-1 in the fifth place match ... Jason Miklacic, the number three seed at 197 pounds, fell in the championship match to top seed Chris McNally of Western Maryland 18-6, earning a second-place finish ... Western Maryland won the team tournament, totaling 153 team points ... The Tomcats finished eighth with 50.5 team points.

# PAC WRESTLING NOTES

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson wrestling team placed fourth of 12 teams at the Petrofes Tournament on Saturday afternoon at Messiah College ... The fourthplace finish was W&J's best ever in 32 years in the tournament ... The Presidents finished the two-day event with 91.5 points ... Senior 184-pounder Wes Koteski and freshman 165-pounder Aaron Gibbs both claimed individual titles in their respective weight classes ... Koteski won the 184-pound weight class as the top seed with a 7-5 decision over Springfield's Tom Medonis in the championship match ... Boone, the second seed at 165, picked up his title by pinning Justin Chandler of Oneonta State in the final match in 1:52 ... He also was awarded the "Most Falls In The Quickest Time" trophy following the tournament after winning three matches by pinfall in 3:59 ... No. 1 seeded junior Kevin DeJulius placed second in the 133-pound weight class, defeating Muhlenberg's Nate Yeasted, 10-1, in the semifinals before being pinned by **Dan** Patterson of Western Maryland in the finals ... Senior 197-pounder Tony Smith and freshman 174-pounder Matt Smith also placed fifth in their respective divisions ... Western Maryland was awarded the team title after finishing the competition with 153 points ... W&J will next be in action on January 5th as the Pennsylvania/New York Dual Meet at RIT.
