Murphy earned the award for the second consective week after posting a 3-1 mark and finishing second at 165 pounds at the RIT Invitational in Rochester, N.Y. He won his first three matches before falling to sixth-seeded Steve Martell of Johnson & Wales by injury default in the championship match.

Also nominated was sophomore 149-pounder **Pete Elers** of Washington & Jefferson and sophomore 174-pounder **Tyler Allen** of Waynesburg.

The Tomcat wrestling squad finished in 10th place with 63.5 team points at the 39th Annual RIT Invitational Saturday in Rochester, N.Y. ... Johnson & Wales took home the team title with

118.0 points, followed by Wilkes University in second with 101.5 points and SUNY-Cortland in third with 98.5 points ... Junior 165-pound Corey Murphy finished second on the day with a 3-1 record ... Murphy fell in the championship match to sixth-ranked Steve Martell of Johnson & Wales by injury default ... Junior 285-pound Kyle Brown finished third on the day, finishing with a 4-1 record ... He fell in the semifinals to Baldwin-Wallace's Bryan Kmetz 3-2 via a tiebreaker ... Freshman 125-pound Anthony Duffield finished sixth for the Tomcats.

Washington & Jefferson competed at the York Spartan Invitational on Saturday and York won the team title with 89.5 points ... Delaware Valley took second place with 68.5 points followed by Montclair State (50.5),

Gloucester County (48.5), W&J (11) and Maryland-Baltimore County (10) ... Sophomore 149-pounder Pete Elers was the only President to make it to the championship finals; however, he was pinned by Delaware Valley's Ryan Herwig in 2:19 ... Elers advanced to the title bout with a 7-0 win over York's Phil DeGaetano and a 3-2 decision versus Montclair State's Alan Aponte ... Freshman 184-pounder Chris Price made it to the consolation bracket finals against York's Kevin Ruff, but fell by a 10-4 count ... Freshman 174-pounder Patrick Wilson and freshman 165-pounder Cory Humes both notched one victory for the Presidents ... W&J will now be idle from competition for over a month until returning to action January 14th at the Washington and Lee Invitational in Lexington, Va.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



After a two-week layoff, the Waynesburg College wrestling team returned to the mats on Saturday at the 39th annual RIT Invitational ... The Yellow Jackets posted a score of 29.5 points to finish 14th in an 18-team field ...

Sophomore Tyler Allen posted four wins for a team-best fourth-place finish, while senior Ken Laird registered a team-high five victories ... Allen entered the 174-lbs. bracket as the fourth seed and posted a 6-1 decision in his opening bout ... He also won his next to matching, including one via pinfall at 3:56, before losing in the seimfinals ... After Allen lost in the semi, he registered a 6-2 decision in his first match of the consolation bracket to advance to third-place bout, where he lost 7-2 to the first seed of the bracket ... Laird posted a 10-1 decision in his opening match of the 149-lbs. bracket before registering a pinfall at 1:50 in his next match ... After being forced to the consolation bracket, Laird won three bouts, including the fifth-place match by a 5-2 decision ... Jim Weishaar and L.R. Neubauer each posted a win at 133-lbs. and heavyweight, respectively, at the RIT Invitational.
