## PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

### MATT SMITH Washington & Jefferson College Senior - 174 pounds Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Smith posted three victories and captured the 174-pound championship at the York Spartan Invitational in York, Pa., this weekend. He captured the title match by fall in 1:36 over **Jake Beitz** of Montclair State.

Also nominated was junior 285-pounder **Kyle Brown** of Thiel and freshman 125-pounder **Matthew Smith** of Waynesburg.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat wrestling team finished fourth (of 15 teams) at Saturday's Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT) Invitational in Rochester, N.Y ... Thiel had five wrestlers place at the event and finished ahead of two teams that had been ranked in the top 25 nationally ... Freshman Anthony McCorvey was the Tomcat's top performer, finishing second at 157 pounds ... Junior heavyweight Kyle Brown earned a third-place finish while recording four pins and beating fifth-ranked Justin Deveau of Rhode Island College ... Freshman Lee Beatty wrestled to a fifth-place finish at 133 pounds while junior Ted Mangan finished sixth at 157 pounds.

## PAC WRESTLING NOTES

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Senior Matt Smith claimed the 174pound title and the Presidents finished fourth out of five teams on Saturday at the 2004 York College Spartan Wrestling Invitational ... York won the team championship with 100.5 points, while Delaware Valley was second with 58. Montclair State (44) finished third followed by W&J (43.5) and Delaware State (40) ... Smith pinned Steve Lewis of Delaware Valley in 6:02 in his first match and then posted a 17-2 major decision over Delaware State's Chris Woodall ... Smith won the championship after defeating Montclair State's Jake Beitz by fall (1:36) ... Junior 197-pounder Ryan Wiles, sophomore 133-pounder Mark Day and freshmen 125-pounder Jacob Habel and 141-pounder Pete Elers all placed fourth in their respective brackets ... Habel recorded wins over Delaware Valley's Ryan Finkbiner (2-0) and York's Gary Heckler (5-4), while Day earned a 15-2 major decision against Delaware State's Jerry Davis ... Elers picked up his lone win against Montclair State's Edgar Feebles (8-1), while Wiles dropped both of his matches to York's Drew Baldauf by 8-6 and 9-7 margins ... Washington & Jefferson opens its 2004-05 home schedule by hosting Pensacola Christian on January 5th at 7:00 pm.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg placed fifth in the 12-team Kutztown Wrestling Invitational on Nov. 24 ... The host Golden Bears won the event with 106 points, while the Yellow Jackets posted 34 points ... A total of five Jacket wrestlers placed at the invitational, including third-place finishes by junior captain Ken Laird at 149-pounds and Matthew Smith at 125-pounds ... Both posted 2-1 records on way to their places ... Freshman heavyweight Daniel Goulart led the Jackets with four wins ... He placed fifth in the weight class with a 4-1 record ... At the Messiah-Petrofes Invitational on Dec. 4, the Jackets placed seventh in a 12-team field ... Springfield won the event with 170.5 points, while the Yellow Jackets posted 63 points ... Five Jacket wrestlers placed at the invitational, including a third and fourth-place finish ... Smith again placed third for WC at 125-pounds with a 4-1 record after defeating the No. 3 seed, with a 3-1 decision in the third-place bout ... Smith, the No. 6 seed, advanced to the semifinals, where he lost to Derek McNerney of Springfield, the No. 2 seed ... Fellow freshman Tyler Allen finished fourth in the 165-pound bracket and led the Jackets with a 5-2 mark at the invitational ... He lost in the first-round to the No. 2 seed ... Allen, who entered the tournament unranked, advanced to the third-place bout, where he lost via a 5-0 decision to the No. 1 seed ... At 149-pounds, Laird posted a 3-2 mark on way to placing seventh at the invitational ... Two of his three wins came by major decision.
