PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

MATT KIRSOPP

Thiel College

Freshman - 141 pounds Pittsburgh, Pa./Chartiers Valley H.S.

Kirsopp went 3-1 and placed second at 141 pounds this weekend at the Messiah-Petrofes Invitational. Kirsopp defeated Byron Johnson of Washington & Jefferson, the second seed in the class, 5-3 in the opening match of the invitational. He then went on to earn pinfall victories pver Brian Pulsinelli of Oneonta (2:53) and Geoff Harner of Messiah (1:15) before falling 4-3 to Kris Harrington of Brockport in the championship match.

Also nominated was senior 133-pounder **Kevin DeJulius** of Washington & Jefferson and sophomore 133-pounder **Derek Maple** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

he Tomcat wrestlers finished 12th at last weekend's Messiah-Petrofes Invitational, hosted by Messiah College ... Freshman Matt Kirsopp (141) was the Tomcats top performer of the weekend finishing in second place ... Kirsopp defeated W&J's Byron Johnson, the class' second seed, 5-3 in his first match of the invite ... Before losing 4-3 to Brockport's Kris **Harrington** in the championship match, Kirsopp pinned Oneonta's Brian Pulsinelli in 2:53 and Messiah's Geoff Harner in 1:15 ... Junior Rob Regner (125) earned a seventh-place finish by defeating Oneonta's Josh Cuomo 3-2 ... Regner lost his initial match of the invite to Cuomo after suffering a pin in 3:27, but was able to hold on for the victory over Cuomo in the seventh-place match.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson wrestling team placed 10th out of 13 teams on Saturday afternoon at the Petrofes Tournament, hosted by Messiah College ... The Presidents finished with 55 points ... Brockport State (N.Y.) won the tournament with seven first-place winners and 178 points ... Messiah finished second with 118.5 points, while Oneonta State was third with 108.5 points ... Two W&J grapplers earned runner-up finishes in their respective brackets ... Top-seeded senior Kevin DeJulius placed second at 133 pounds, while sophomore Matt Smith earned runner-up laurels at 174 pounds ... DeJulius picked up a 12-7 quarterfinal decision over Tyler Alexander of Messiah and a 9-4 semifinal victory over Gettysburg's Steve Kareha to move into the championship match against second-seeded Jason **Meister** of Baptist Bible; however, Meister won the title bout with a 10-3 triumph ... Smith, the No. 2 seed, earned his sixthstraight victory by pinfall in the quarterfinals and then defeated Tony Valenti of Messiah in the semifinals, 8-5 ... Brockport State's Don Favro, the bracket's top seed, won the championship match by a 9-4 margin ... Junior Byron Johnson fought back from a quarterfinal loss to post a fourth-place finish at 141 pounds. ... He entered the tournament as the No. 2 seed and fell to Mount Union's Kyle Holler in the thirdplace match, 7-1 ... Freshman 149pounder Joe Santina also placed eighth.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg struggled at the Rochester Institute of Technology tournament with 23 points, placing 14 out of 15 squads ... The Jackets beat out Tompkins Cortland Community College for 14th place, while tournament champion Ithaca (144), John Carroll (124) and Baldwin-Wallace (108.5) rounded out the top three, respectively ... Sophomore **Derek Maple** was the only Jacket to place during the tournament ... Maple captured sixth place in the 133pound weight class ... He lost two decisions to Baldwin-Wallace's Jeff Varney: an 8-6 decision in the first round and a 5-2 decision in the consolation bracket ... Maples recorded four wins, including over sixth-seeded Anthony Montes of Johnson & Wales, and three losses.
