SRU when junior 285-pound **Kyle Brown** won a 5-3 decision in the final bout of the evening ... Sophomore **Anthony Prvonozac** was Thiel's top performer, finishing sixth at 141 pounds ... Prvonozac, who entered the invitational as the fourth seed, was 2-1 at the invitational, falling to **Nick Sanchez** of Heidelberg College by medical forfeit in the fifth-place match.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



The Yellow Jackets placed 20th at the 25th-annual Ohio Northern Invitational on Saturday ... Among the 20 schools in attendance were five Division II programs, a pair of Division III top 25 teams and two NAIA schools,

both of which were also ranked in the top 25 ... Three of the six Waynesburg wrestlers posted a win, including **Dave Thorn** and **Ken Laird**, both of whom registered multiple victories ... At 125-lbs., Thorn won his opening match against the seventh seed via forfeit before losing his next match ... In the wrestleback, the junior posted a 7-2 decision before narrowly suffering a 4-3 loss in the subsequent match ... Laird, one of two seniors on this year's team, entered the 20-team tournament as the seventh seed in the 149-lbs. bracket ... He recorded a major decision victory in his first match, 11-1, before adding a 5-0 decision in his second match ... However, Laird lost his third-round match against the second-seed by a 6-4 decision ... In his first match of the wrestleback, Laird suffered a 13-9 defeat ... Freshman **Jason Weeks** claimed a 6-5 decision in his opening-round bout at 165-lbs., before losing his next two matches.
