## PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

## KYLE BROWN

**Thiel College** 

Junior - 285 pounds Meadville, Pa./Meadville H.S.

Brown earned his third PAC Wrestler of the Week honor in four weeks after going 4-1 and finishing second at 285 pounds at the Ohio Northern Invitational in Ada, Ohio, on Saturday. Brown defeated the top seed 8-6 in the semifinals before falling 2-1 to a Division II wrestler in the championship match. He raised his 2004-05 record to 18-3 on the season

Also nominated was freshman 165-pounder **Tyler Allen** of Waynesburg.

# PAC WRESTLING NOTES

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat wrestling team found its way into the top 30 of the latest Brute-Adidas National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) Division III team rankings ... Thiel is ranked 22nd in the third team ranking of the season ... Thiel dropped a home dual meet 29-12 to Mt. Union Wednesday before finishing sixth at Saturday's Ohio Northern University Invitational ... The Tomcats finished with 66.0 team points and were the highest finisher of any of the participating Division III teams ... Junior Kyle Brown continued his terrific season by going 4-1 and finishing second at 285 pounds ... Brown, who entered the tournament as the number five seed, picked up a 6-2 decision over fourthseeded Jared Poweski of Mount St. Joseph in the championship quarterfinals before posting an 8-6 decision over topseeded Chris Bulley of West Liberty State in the championship semifinals ... Brown fell to second-seeded Aldo Campea of Ashland 2-1 in the finals ... Sophomore Corey Murphy finished third at 165 pounds ... Murphy, who came into the tournament as the third seed, lost to Kirk Main of West Liberty State by pin fall (5:20) in the championship quarterfinals, but bounced back to win four straight matches, culminating with a medical forfeit win over Main in the third-place match ... Freshman Anthony McCorvey wrestled to a sixth-place finish at 149 pounds while sophomore Nate Santelli finished eighth at 184 pounds.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Freshman Tyler Allen was the lone Waynesburg College wrestler to place at the Ohio Northern Invitational ... Waynesburg placed 15th in a 16-team field, that included six nationally-ranked teams and NCAA Division II schools ... Ashland, a D-II school ranked No. 11, won the invitational for the second straight year, scoring 208 points total ... West Liberty State (W.Va.) was second with 114.5 points, while Gannon (Pa.) was third with 95.5 ... Allen entered the invitational as the No. 6 seed in the 165-pound bracket and posted a team-best 4-2 record ... He lost his opening round match by decision before winning two straight matches, including one by pin fall ... Juniors Ken Laird at 149-pounds and Chris Van Dine at 174-pounds were the only other Yellow Jackets to post multiple victories at the invitational.
