PAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

STEVE DEDRICK

Thiel College

Senior - 149 pounds Erie, Pa./General McLane H.S.

Dedrick led the Tomcats to a ninth-place finish at the Ohio Northern Invitational this weekend, after placing fourth overall in the 149-pound division. He posted a 5-2 record on the day after entering the tournament as the #6 seed.

Also nominated was junior 141-pounder **Chris Vicente** of Waynesburg.

PAC WRESTLING NOTES

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished ninth (37.5 pts) at the Ohio Northern University InvitationI in Ada, Ohio, on Saturday ... Senior 149pound Steve Dedrick and freshman 141pound Matt Kirsopp led the Tomcat performers with fourth-place finishes in their respective weight classes ... Dedrick entered the invitational as the sixth seed at 149 and opened with a 19-4 tech fall (5:55) win over Manchester's Jonathon Polomchak, then defeated the University of Indianapolis' Wes Hall 10-6 ... After the victory over Hall, he fell to thirdseeded Tony Patrizi of Heidelberg 10-4 ... Dedrick battled back in the losers bracket with wins over eight-seeded Ken Laird of Waynesburg (16-6), seventhseeded Dan Irwin of Manchester (17-6) and fourth-seeded Jeremy Salyers of Heidelberg (medical forfeit) ... In the third place match Dedrick fell to Rocky Burkett, the fifth seed from Manchester, 5-2 ... Kirsopp went in as the fifth seed at 141, earning a bye in the first round of action ... He wrestled to wins over Tanner Yates of the University of Indianapolis (6-4) and fourth-seeded Nick Koons of Manchester (medical forfeit) before losing to Indianapolis' Josh Holden, the class' first seed, 13-6 ... After a huge tech fall victory over Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) rival Chris Vincente of Waynesburg (16-0, 4:40), Kirsopp fell in the third place match to second-seeded Sayre Wurh of Baldwin-Wallace 11-6.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Three Yellow Jackets placed at the Ohio Northern University Invitational Saturday, as Waynesburg finished 10th in the 13team field ... The Invitational featured three Division II squads and three nationally-ranked Division III squads ... Five Yellow Jackets were seeded, while three placed, including unseeded Bryan Patnesky at 174 ... Patnesky later captured seventh place with a win over Olivet's **Drew Graham** by a 8-6 decision. Chris Vicente took home fifth place in the 141-pound bracket ... After advancing with two wins in the losers' bracket, he lost to Thiel's Matt Kirsopp on a tech fall at 4:40 ... Vicente finished the day on a winning note with a 10-4 decision over Mount St. Joseph's Tim Harrison in the fifth-place bout ... Chris Pierce took eighth in the heavyweight bracket ... Pierce defeated Heidelberg's Matt Coniglio, 9-5, before two straight losses to end the tournament.
