Carnegie Mellon handed Washington & Jefferson its first loss of the 2003 campaign on Friday evening in Pittsburgh ... CMU scored two goals in the first 21 minutes of the game and cruised to the four-goal win ... The Tartans outshot the Presidents, 12-3 ... Sophomore forward Jen Pergola attempted all three President shots ... Junior goalkeeper Gretchen Weber made eight saves for W&J.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opens play Wednesday at La Roche ... The home opener is Friday against Thomas More, starting a four-match home stand for the Lady Wolverines.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

In its first action of the season, Waynesburg dropped two games at the Shenandoah Shootout ... Sophomore Alicia Lotti netted Waynesburg's lone goal against Shenandoah ... Lotti's goal in the 30th minute was unassisted ... The Hornets took a 3-0 in the first half on two goals by Karen Hild ... In the opener on Saturday, the Wilmington peppered the Jackets with 49 shots (30 on goal), while Waynesburg could only manage two ... Lyndsey Acker made 19 saves in net for Waynesburg yielding all 10 goals, including a pair of hat tricks by Katie Foucht and Emily Bulach ... Waynesburg returns to action Saturday when it hosts the First Annual Yellow Jacket Shootout beginning at noon against Bryn Mawr, followed by Delaware Valley vs. Lake Erie.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel hosted its Women's Soccer Classic for the second straight year last weekend ... After getting underway an hour late, Thiel and Ursuline went into halftime tied at 1-1 ... Freshman Lindsay Cimino put Thiel up 1-0 just 9:04 into the first period ... After a pair of early second half goals from the Arrows, freshmen Holly Schaefer scored at the 34:43 mark of the second half to pull Thiel to within a goal, 3-2 ... Ursuline finished with a 24-4 shot advantage in the contest ... Sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore recorded three saves in the loss...On Saturday the Tomcats dropped a 4-1 decision to Marymount (VA) ... Schaefer tallied the lone goal for the Tomcats in the second hal ... Dunsmore made 11 saves in the loss.

Westminster Titans

Westminster opened its 2003 season at the Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT) Invitational in Rochester, N.Y., over the weekend ... The Lady Titans defeated Ramapo (N.J.) College 2-0 in an opening round game, but were defeated in the title game by the host school 2-0 ...
