Pazehoski earned the first PAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week honor in 2002 after scoring two goals and adding one assist in W&J's season-opening 4-0 shutout win over Penn State-Altoona on Saturday.

Also nomionated was senior MF **Missy Gibson** of Bethany, freshman F **Meghan Lacey** of Waynesburg and sophomore GK **Lisa Santoriella** of Westminster.

#### **Bethany Bison**

In opening the season with a 1-1 record, Bethany earned second place at the inaugural Gallaudet Tournament ... Midfielder Missy Gibson and forward Erica Jackson scored two goals each and midfielder Kylie Harvey had two assists as Bethany knocked off the hosts, 5-1 ... Cara Pasquinelli scored the first goal of the game for the Green and White ... In the championship game, Gibson tied the game with her third goal of the weekend in the 58th minute but Gwynedd-Mercy tallied the game-winner in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute ... Three Bison players were named to the All-Tournament team, including Gibson, Pasquinelli and Megan Maloney.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson gave Head Coach Melissa Joseph her first career victory in her first-ever game by blanking Penn State-Altoona, 4-0 ... The victory marked W&J's first in season opener since an 8-0 shutout of Chatham in 1995 ... The four goals scored by W&J also was the most goals scored in a game since a 4-0 win over Thiel on Sept. 16, 2000 ... The Presidents got two goals and one assist from sophomore Carrie Pazehoski ... Pazehoski equaled her entire goal putout from the 2001 season in the season's first game ... Freshmen Jen Pergola and Toni Lynn Simonini also added a goal apiece ... Sophomore goalkeeper Gretchen Weber made 10 saves in recording her second career shutout.
