Bethany fell to 0-2 on the year with a heart-breaking overtime loss to Marietta on Sunday ... The visitors controlled most of the action, outshooting the Bison 13-2 in the game ... Bethany goalkeeper Maggie Kuhn had a great game, stopping seven shots overall (including six in the second half) ... Bethany will try to break into the win column this week with a pair of home games against Pitt-Greensburg on Tuesday and Thiel on Sunday.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson routed Hiram in Ohio on Saturday behind two goals and one assist from freshman forward Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli ... Loffreda-Mancinelli scored both of W&J's first-half goals in the first 17 minutes of the contest ... Sophomores Jen Pergola, Toni Lynn Simonini and Rachel Campbell all scored second-half goals as the Presidents cruised to the win ... Junior goalie Gretchen Weber made 10 saves for the Presidents, who outshot HC by a 20-12 margin ... Oberlin held a 5-0 lead with 19 minutes remaining on Sunday before two goals each from junior Carrie Pazehoski and Pergola cut the lead to 5-4 with 49 seconds left ... Pergola and Pazehoski both added one assist in the loss ... Weber stopped eight OC shots.

### Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened season with two "home" matches at Slippery Rock University last weekend ... Grove City recorded the program's 100<sup>th</sup> all-time win Saturday ... Grove City is 100-88-11 since 1992, including five league titles ... Senior Meg Tilley accounted for all three Lady Wolverine goals over the weekend ... Sophomore goalkeeper Lindsay Thompson notched her first win Saturday with a shutout, also the first of her career ... The team's match with La Roche has been moved from Sept. 3 to Oct. 30 due to field conditions at La Roche.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

As hosts of the first annual Yellow Jacket Shootout, Waynesburg went 1-1 over the weekend recording its first win of the season over Lake Erie in Sunday's consolation game ... The Jackets lost a heartbreaking 2-1 game against Bryn Mawr in the first round ... The Owls scored with five seconds left in the game, after Jackie Sassaman tied the game 1-1 with a goal in the 45<sup>th</sup> minute ... Sassaman scored her second goal of the week in the consolation game on an assist from Emily Byers ... She registered seven shots (four on goal) in the win ... Janette Schuessler's goal in the 24<sup>th</sup> minute proved to be the game-winner ... Delaware Valley captured the tournament in a shootout after a 2-2 tie with Bryn Mawr.

The Thiel women's soccer team finished last week with a 0-3 record, recording two of those losses at the SUNY-Fredonia Days Inn Tournament in Fredonia, NY last weekend ... The Lady Titans, ranked seventh in the region by the NSCAA this week, went 2-1 in non-conference action ...
